

RULES OF THE LIBRARY.

- The Library is open from 7.30 p. m., to 9 p. m., daily.
1. Members are entitled to one volume only at a time.
 2. One additional volume may be had on payment of 5 cents, for every 10 days or fraction of 10 days in advance.
 3. A Member retaining any Book longer than the time specified therein, shall pay the following fines:—for new paper cover Novels and Magazines, 3 cents per day; and for other Books, 1 cent per day.
 4. No Book shall be kept on hand for any Member.
 5. No Book shall be renewed more than once.
 6. No Member by whom any fee, fine or other charge is due, and to whom notice thereof has been issued, shall, until payment is made, be allowed to take any Book.
 7. Members dissatisfied with any charges claimed, may pay the same under protest, and the Library Committee will decide the matter in dispute; but no protest can be received until the fee is paid, and the protest must be made at the time of payment.
 8. Members who shall injure, destroy, or lose any of the Books of the Institute, shall forthwith pay the value of the damage done, or of the Book lost, as may be determined.
 9. Books defaced with marks or writing, shall be considered as injured, and assessed accordingly.
 10. No Book shall be considered as returned by any Member, unless it is handed, together with the Member's Register number, to the person in charge of the Register.
 11. Members are prohibited from lending Books, or exchanging them with others.
 12. Members taking Books from the Library without having them entered are subject to expulsion or prosecution, as the Directors may decide. Subscribers are subject to the same regulations as Members.




