Department of Agriculture, Commissioners' Branch. OTTAWA, APRIL 28, 1904. Any of the more thoughtful and public spirited men of the Dominion are numbered among the officers and members of the Canadian Association for the Prevention of Consumption and other forms of Tuberculosis, which held its fourth annual meeting in Ottawa on April 20th and 21st. Every thinking man and woman must be impressed with the necessity for united action to check the ravages of a disease which causes one death in every eight in this country, and gives rise to a vast amount of suffering and permanent ill-health. It is calculated that in Canada at the present moment between 30,000 and 40,000 persons are suffering from it, yet it is undoubtedly a preventable disease, and one that is curable in its earlier stages. The report of the executive council pointed out that the operations of the association have combined with other influences to concentrate public attention in some degree upon the consumption and to awaken a desire for information regarding the measures which should be taken to stay its ravages. The Secretary, Rev. D. Moore, of Ottawa, during the year distributed by mail and otherwise over 100,000 leaflets on "How to Prevent Consumption," "Basis for Consumption," etc. Many lectures
