Mr. Howland sweeps the Province yesterday with a rush. His majority in the new House will probably be 22. This is a gain of anything from six to nine seats, and possibly twice as much as the old House. This estimate does not include the possible defeat of Mr. Sol. White in North Essex. The fight there was very warm. There is also some doubt about the result in West Kent, and possibly in two or three other constituencies. The vote and majority were not in such a straggling and uncertain manner as having that they are more than omitted in the table that follows.

The table, however, contains the members elected for each constituency with their political affiliations. The names printed in italics are members who were not in the last House. The vote cast in the election of 1888, or in the bye-elections since, is also given in the table. These were three elections by poll, 2 Liberal and 1 Conservative. In all the two Liberal members are continued over from the last House.
