Mr. Rose's Trustee Election Bill

The new bill for the election of School Trustees, which has been introduced in the House of Commons, is as follows:

1. In cities, towns, and villages, and townships, where, by law, a Public School Board is established, the nominations and elections of Public School Trustees shall be held at the same time and place, and by the same returning officer, and conducted in the same manner as the nominations and elections of councilors and the qualifications of voters for school trustees shall be the same as councilors.

2. A separate set of ballot papers shall be prepared for the wards or electoral divisions, containing the names of the candidates nominated for School Trustees, as amended, by substituting the "first Monday in January" for the "second Wednesday in January," as the day upon which the trustees are to be elected, and the names of the candidates shall be printed on the ballot papers.

3. In the list of qualified voters required to be delivered to the returning officer by the clerk of the municipality before the opening of the poll, the clerk shall place opposite the names of the voters on said list who have been returned to him as supporters of separate schools, the letters S.S. (signifying supporters of separate schools), and the returning officer shall not deliver to any voter a ballot paper unless he is a supporter of separate schools.

4. In the case of a school trustee, if he is a supporter of separate schools, he shall be entitled to vote for the trustees of the separate school, and if he is not a supporter of separate schools, he shall be entitled to vote for the trustees of the common school.
