The United States and Mexico — The following is a copy of the capty given by Lord Abordeen to the themorial of an association interested in Mexican affairs:

'Foreign office, London, Jame 6, 1846.

Six:-1 am directed by the Earl of Abordeen to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd that, in which you call his lordship's attention to the disastrons results which are to be apprehended from the hostilities which have broken out between the United States and Mexico, and express a hope on the part of the South American and Mexican according to the Mexico and Carlon that her Myjesty's government may doen it expedient to interpose their good offices in order to effect a reconciliation between those two governments.
