

THE CANADA TEMPERANCE ACT.—On Tuesday, Mr. James Tennant was arraigned before Police Magistrate Marsh, on a charge of having violated the provisions of the Canada Temperance Act, by selling and supplying for the prosecution and Mr. Bainford the defense. Several witnesses were called by Mr. Logan, and failing to elicit any material from them he asked the defendant be sworn. Mr. Tennant refused to be sworn, and was committed to jail for five days for contempt.

Mr. Bainford applied to Judge Weldon the same afternoon for a writ of habeas corpus, and the matter was assigned to Judge Weldon for trial tomorrow morning. The section of the Canada Temperance Act giving the prosecution authority to call defendant in question was read, and the following was the substance of the proceedings:

His honor this morning gave judgment on the writ of habeas corpus of Mr. Tennant on the ground that the 123rd Section of the Canada Temperance Act did not apply to a sale of liquors.
