

THE ASYLUM OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD.



The Asylum of the Good Shepherd, at Quebcc, offers a refuge to the Penitent and a safeguard to the nocent who are in danger. It was opened on the 12th of January, 1850, under the auspices of Religion.—sonly resources are those which Divine Providence and christian charity provide. So far they have not ited. God, of his infinity goodness and mercy, has inspired generous women with the noble thought of evoting themselves to the solvation and reformation of the most degraded of their sex; every one who nows the value of a soul redeemed by the blood of our Saviour Jesus Christ appreciated such a thought, and though it would have seemed that charity had exhausted all her funds in works of an equally estimable attre, she had yet her mite to offer for the asylum of the Good Shepherd. Each one has offered his. The lergy, the Religious Communities, The Society of St. Vincent of Paul, generous christians, pions Ladies, I have made it a duty as well a pleasure, to come to its assistance. Does not this admirable co operation which the asylum of the Good Shepherd becomes, in a manner, the work of all, assure us that it will rosper? Does it not seem to say: "The hand of God is here!"

Thanks to this assistance the asylum of the Good Shepherd possesses at the present moment a modest welling in De Lachevrotière street, St. Lonis suburbs, in which 20 Penitents are hving under the direction 19 mistresses. Their daily labour, the work of their hands is sanctified by prayer. They pray for their enefactors. The Penitents never leave the precincts of the establishment which protects them; they erform their religious duties in a chapel in the interior. Their nearest relatives, alone, can converse with em, by permission of the Superior, and in the presence of a Mistress. This confined state of existence aust necessarily be painful for persons whose former habits were of a very different nature; several, owever, among whom is the one who was first admitted into the asylum, bear it with courage and even ith joy. They know that it is their road to Heaven.

These 20 Penitents are not the only ones to whom the establishment has proved useful; others have pent in it a time of more or less duration; of these, 12 have been placed as servants, 7 restored to their arents, and one was reunited to her husband after a separation of 15 years. Some, it is true, have fallen new, but we venture to hope that even they will derive some benefit from their sojourn in the asylum of ne Good Shepherd. At all events, the consoling dispositions in which two of these unfortunate creatures are died, would seem to confirm us in that idea.

In order to point out more fully the necessity and utility of this establishment, we may add, that of the Penitents admitted made their first communion, 7 acceived the sacrament of confirmation, ad 2 were baptized, in the asylum.

These happy results of a work which is yet in its very infancy are an earnest of the benefits of which will be productive as it increases, and they are very encouraging to all who take an interest in it. The onse has already proved too small, and the Superior has been under the painful necessity of refusing admittance to several unfortunate females, who hoped to find a refuge in it. A larger Building, then, must be rected. It is with this view that His Grace, the Archbishop, has appealed to the Faithful residing in the lountry parts; it is, also, for the same object that a Bazaar will be opened on the 25th of this month, which Il christian and governus hearts will not fail to patronize.
