Eminent Painter of Church Interiors. Born 1817, died 1891. Numerous Decorations and Medals. His work is to be found in almost all museums of Europe and America, and in many private collections.

BLOMMERS (BERNARDUS JOHANNES). Scheveningen.

Painter of Dutch Interiors and Seaside Scenes and Fisher Life. Pupil of the Academy of The Hague. Gold Medals awarded at The Hague, Amsterdam, Munich, Brussels. Honorary Diplomas: Antwerp, Amsterdam, Chicago, Brussels. Gold Medal: Paris, 1900; St. Louis, 1904. Decorations: Chevalier of the Order of Saint Michael of Bavaria, Leopold of Belgium, and Nederlandsche Leeuw. His work is represented in the principal Museums of Holland and in many national and private collections.

Portrait and Genre-Painter. Born 1833. Student at the Academy of Amsterdam. Awarded: Honorable Mention, Antwerp; Gold Medals in Munich and Chicago. Her work is represented in noted collections.

ISRAELS (JOSEF). The Hague.

Portrait and Genre-painter, also Scenes on the Sands and Landscapes with Figures: The life of the Fisher-folk in and out of doors in hours of recreation or of hard work, furnish him subjects for many of his best known canvases. Born 1824, at Groningen. Awarded many Medals at domestic and foreign Exhibitions, among which was the Grand Prix at the Paris Exhibition, 1900. Decorations: Knight of the Order of the Lion of the Netherlands, Officer of the Legion of Honor, Knight of the Leopold's Order of Belgium, Knight of the Franz Joseph's Order of Austria, Knight of the Crown Order of Italy. His work is represented in all of the important Public and Private Galleries of Holland and many foreign collections and Museums, also in the United States and Canada.

KATE TEN (HERMAN FREDERIK KAREL) Deceased.

Painter of Historical Subjects, principally of the 17th Century. Born 1822, died 1891. Pupil of Kruseman. Decorated with High Orders of Holland, the Legion of Honor, the Order of Leopold, and Franz Joseph. Represented in the Principal Museums of Holland and in many Private Collections elsewhere.

Painter of Dutch City Views. Born 1852. Pupil of C. Bissehop and The Hague Academy. Awarded Medals and repeatedly decorated. Represented in the Museums of Amsterdam, Rotterdam, The Hague, United States and Canada, St. Louis, Paris, Venice, etc.

Portrait Painter, also of Figures in Landscape. Born 1856. Pupil of Amsterdam Academy and of Leon Bonnat, Paris. Awarded Honorable Mention, Saion, Paris; Gold Medal, Berlin; Sociétaire, Salon Champ de Mars, Paris; Chevalier of the Orders of the Lion of Netherlands, Legion of Honor, Michael of Bavaria. Represented in the Royal Collections by life-size Portraits of H. M. Willem III, H. M. Queen Emma, and H. M. Queen Wilhelmina. Well known in Canada and United States.

Painter of Landscape, frequently with Cattle. Born 1822, died 1897. Received numerous Awards and Decorations. Represented in all important Museums in Holland.

SADEE (PHILIP).

Genre Painter. Born 1837. Chevalier of the Order of Leopold of Belgium, St. Michael of Bavaria. Represented in the Rijks Museum, Amsterdam, in the collection of H. M. the Queen, and in important Collections.

Figure Painter. One of the best known of the younger men of Holland. Son-in-law of B. J. Blommers. High Honors at St. Louis, Paris, etc.

Painter of Dutch Interiors and Landscape with Figures. Born 1826, died 1896. Pupil of the Antwerp Academy. Awarded Silver Medal, 1847; and Bronze, 1871. Gold Medals, 1874, 1888; Silver Medal, Honorable Mention, Paris, London, Berlin. Represented in the Principal Museums of Holland and in Dutch and Foreign Private Collections.

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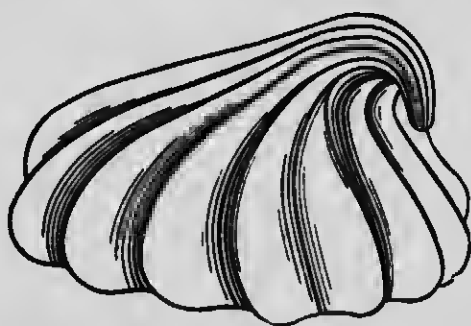
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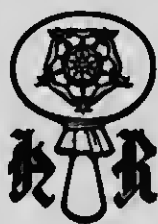
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
