RESOLUTION OF COMMITTEE.

"That the Secretary shall, previously to each Quarterly Meeting, prepare a tabular view of the numerical and financial state of the Missions, also a synoptical statement of the business to be done. And in order to do this, Missions shall hold their quarterly meetings sufficiently early to enable them to have their reports to the Mission Office not less than one week previously to the meeting of the Committee: and in case any of the Missionaries shall fail in doing so, their reports shall not be read, nor their grants sent until the succeeding meeting. The Committee earnestly hope that all the brethren will assist in enabling the Secretary to carry out the above arrangement, so that they may have time to discuss what really pertains to the Mission work.

"The Quarterly Meeting of these Committees shall be held in Toronto, on Thursday, the 7th of August, and Thursday, the 6th of November, 1879; on Thursday, the 5th of February, and Thursday, the 7th of May, 1880. Each meeting to commence at nine o'clock A.M."

REPORT.

To the Friends and Supporters of the Primitive Methodist Missions of Canada.

DEAR FRIENDS.—We again, with much pleasure, lay before you the report of this society. We cannot give you a full report of all that has been done during the past year. The abundant labours of the servants of Christ, ministerial and lay, their struggles with difficulties, their anxieties about the work in its various branches and relations, their self-denial and in some cases even suffering, mental and physical; the evidences of zeal, of love to Christ and souls; of moral courage in the face of opposition; of heart-felt sorrow when there has been the temporary absence of fruit for their labours; of joy and holy triumph when victory has been won, and their toils and devotion have been followed by success in soul-saving and prosperity of the Church's work. These things it is impossible fully to report; all we can do is to refer to them in general terms, and give a few brief examples. But there is One who knows them all, keeps a strict account of them all, puts a proper estimate upon them, and will remember and fully reward them in the day of the Lord. What an encouragement to be faithful and not to be weary in well-doing, even though the well doing may be amidst much difficulty and trial! In due season workers for God shall reap if they faint not. It is the Lord's work, and they who are engaged in it are His servants and co-workers with Him. Faithfully doing their duty they may safely trust His own work in His own hands, believing that He will see to it that His own purposes shall not fail; and he has purposed and declared that His word shall not fail, but accomplish that which He pleaseth, and prosper in the thing whereunto He hath sent it. There is a possibility of God's people dishonoring Him by speaking slightly of His cause, and withholding from it that which He has a claim upon for the purpose of spreading His Gospel, and saving those for whom Christ died. Let not this thing be done amongst us, yea, let it not once be named among us; it would be shameful ingratitude, and a sin against God. He has made the Primitive Methodist Church the means, in His hands, of the conversion of hundreds of thousands of souls. In a human life-time he has built up a church which numbers not much short of 200,000 members, and is daily increasing in numbers and strength. In this country God has, by the agency of this church, saved thousands of people, some of whom He has taken to Himself; thousands of others are living and working in other churches in parts of the country where we have no organization, and over 8,300 are in membership with us. Therefore we believe it would be highly dishonoring to God, to do otherwise than praise Him for the good work which has been done and is being done. And not only ought we to honor Him by praise for the past, but by praying for the future to be even more abundant in blessing and success than the past, and by consistently laboring and contributing of our substance for the continued advancement of the church's work with which we are connected.

On our Mission Stations we have 4,263 members. More than 900 persons were added to the Societies during the past year, most of whom were converted from the world, and notwithstanding the great number of deaths, and especially of removals, the increase on our missions was nearly 200, for which we thank God and take courage.

The financial question is one which is considered, (and rightly so), an important question in connection with our Mission work. The question is often

asked, "How are the Missions succeeding financially? What prospect is there of their becoming self-sustaining?" Important questions these, yet not all-important. It is much more important to ask what is being done in soul-saving? and surely over 900 people gathered into the church is a satisfactory answer, and more than commensurate with the amount of money spent by the Missionary Society. But as to becoming self-sustaining some of these missions could not reasonably be expected to do so for some time to come. But these are not generally expensive Missions, and to continue for a length of time to assist such stations is a real service to the cause of Christ, and an unspeakable blessing to the people; so that such aid given is doing great and permanent good and glorifying God. Then some of these stations at important points, which are centres of population, and which are sometimes spoken of as places which ought to stand alone, are fast preparing to do so; but it is considered better to give them time to become strong enough to be fully able to hold their position of independence, than to hasten them into such a position, while it is doubtful whether they can hold it or not. They are preparing for it by improving their church property, reducing their church debts, improving their ordinary income, etc.

The following brief extracts will serve as examples of what work is being done on our Mission Stations:

"BRADFORD.—*Dear Bro. Bee.*—During the last year the Lord of Hosts has been with us. In the town church some fifty persons found Christ, forty of whom united with us in church fellowship. The Sabbath School, the class meeting, prayer-meeting, young men's meeting, and Bible class, are all well sustained. The congregations are good; the country is also doing well numerically and financially. Two years ago the ordinary income was \$187.79 for the year, it is now \$323.80. The missionary money was \$81.48, it is now considerably over \$100.00. The Bradford church has also been repaired to the extent of \$300.00, and paid for. And still our motto is 'Speak to the children of Israel that they go forward.'—THOS. BOYD."

"CARADOC.—*Dear Bro. Bee.*—Although the friends here amongst whom we move are by no means wealthy, they have responded nobly according to their means. We have during the year spent about one hundred dollars in improving one of the places of worship, which sum has all been provided for; and the congregations are in a very healthy state, and the friends on the station are fully resolved, that at no distant date, they will become self-sustaining.—Yours truly, W. HUGGINS."

"CATHCART.—*Dear Bro. Bee.*—Our Church has succeeded, and we stand to-day better than we ever did before. A debt of \$160 on Cathcart Church has been paid off. This spring we built a fine shed for the same Church which cost \$150, and it is paid for. Also we put up a neat fence, and some additional improvements.—Yours, in the work of our Common Master, R. L. OCKLEY."

"COLLINSBY.—The work of God on this mission was vigorously pushed last year. The membership suffered from removals and other causes very much, and in common with others felt the financial pressure of the time; yet by diligence and perseverance the station reported an increase in nearly every department. A protracted meeting was held at Collinsby, at which a number of young people were truly converted to God, and the Church quickened into a higher state of spiritual life. The Sabbath School and congregation of Elginburg Church have greatly increased. The Church has been improved, the whole edifice inside and out being newly painted, with other improvements, gives it a very handsome appearance. At York Road and Sharpton the congregations have greatly increased, and their subscriptions for ministerial support more than double what they previously were. For the most part the people are united and devotedly attached to the cause of God. May they increase in every good word and work.—JOSHUA DYKE."

"FOREST.—*Dear Bro. Bee,*—We have had a busy but blessed year. The hand of our God has been with us for good, for which we adore and praise Him. Numerically, financially, and spiritually, God has blessed us. We have improved the Church property at least \$1,000 during the past year—by finishing Forest Church, building a new one at Kinnaird, and erecting a shed at Zion appointment. We have also raised about \$2,000 for the Church Building Funds by subscriptions, &c. One pleasing feature is that God has given us souls at every appointment during the year, several were saved in the ordinary services. We also held three protracted meetings, and altogether one hundred precious souls were led to Jesus. To God alone be glory forever. We report to conference an increase of 53 members, two Sabbath Schools, 11 teachers, and 80 scholars, also an increase of \$104 in the ordinary income. We have just re-opened our Church at Jura, known as Bethel appointment, which has been closed for more than a year. The first time we preached there we had a large congregation, a blessed service, and we received four persons into church fellowship. Blessing God for the past, praising Him for the present, and trusting Him for the future, we enter upon another connexional year in the name of the Lord, praying that it may be more abundant in blessing than the past.—Yours fraternally, W. A. RODWELL."

"KINCARDINE.—This is not one of the desirable fields of labour.—It has difficulties peculiar to itself, long journeys, heavy roads, small societies, and other difficulties that we need not refer to. During our incumbency the Lord was pleased to bless our labours. We held sixty-six weeks of special meetings, and preached on an average six times per week. Over 200 professed to be converted, and we took between 50 and 60 into the Church. The ordinary income increased about \$375.00 in three years; we had an increase in Missionary money, Sabbath Schools, Teachers and Scholars. During our stay on this station we were much helped and comforted by some of the brethren, who cordially and manfully co-operated with us to extend the interests of Christ's kingdom.—J. W. GILPIN."

"PLATTSVILLE.—On the whole we are pleased to say this mission is doing well. During the past year we opened one new appointment, and have succeeded in gathering a steady congregation. At our other preaching places our congregations have also increased. Our ordinary income was \$60, and our Missionary money \$40, in advance of the previous year.—JOSEPH ASTON."

"ST. CATHARINES.—Your missionary has spent two years of incessant toil and great anxiety on this mission, but the Lord has rewarded us with the joy of success. When we arrived we found that a great number of the members had deserted our church, the congregation was scattered, and the few members who had remained faithful to our cause were greatly discouraged, still we thought that God had a work for us in the city of St. Catharines, so in the name of the Lord we set up our banners, determined for his sake to labour and endure. We succeeded in gathering in a respectable congregation, and the Lord favoured us during the past year with a very gracious revival. We also succeeded in paying about \$300 on the church. We have a society in this city now which is noted for its zeal, activity, and success in the work of God.—N. WELLWOOD."

"WALPOLE.—*My Dear Bro. Bee,*—We are most grateful to be able to say 'The Lord of Hosts is with us, and the God of Jacob is our refuge.' The past year has been a very trying one, but, thank God, prosperous. Our labour has not been in vain in the Lord. Upwards of 30 souls sought for, and I trust found the Saviour. The Mission Fund has been well sustained, there being an increase of \$12. Our ordinary income has increased during the year \$111.00, and we have an increase of one Sabbath School. Our aim is now to consolidate our work by erecting suitable places of worship. May the blessed Lord pour out His Spirit and establish the work of our hands upon us.—I am, yours in Jesus, C. J. DOBSON."

“WINGHAM.—This is the parent of St. Helen's and Grey Missions. Three years ago it gave St. Helen's four appointments and 77 members. Two years ago it gave two appointments and 57 members to assist in organizing the Grey Station. The division left Wingham town with four country appointments and a membership of 120. Since the above arrangements, we have an increase of 30 members on the Wingham Mission. We have also bought a commodious house in a fine situation for a parsonage, which has been thoroughly refitted, making it respectable and comfortable. The Trustees of the Wingham Church have purchased the lot adjoining the church, which being a corner lot makes the property very valuable; the whole has been recently fenced, making a very great improvement to the property. These additions to the connexion's real estate in this rapidly growing town gives the appearance of permanence and respectability to our cause in this place. We trust, by the blessing of God, a career of prosperity is before the Station.—JAMES SMITH.”

Reports of the above character could be continued as evidence of the good work being done, but space forbids. The following statement in brief will show how the Society stands financially. For a fuller statement see the balance sheet at the end of the Report.

From the above balance it will be seen that we are \$333.50 short of paying our way, notwithstanding the strictest economy in every department. Doubtless, but for the hard times, the income would have been much in advance of what it is, and in view of the excellent crops just gathered in, and the very much better circumstances in which the country is likely to be placed, the Committee earnestly hope that contributions to this cause will be largely increased the coming year; and hopefully appeal to the gratitude and liberality of the friends of Christ's cause, to do liberal things for the Mission cause the coming year.

The English Missionary Society, notwithstanding their own indebtedness through the serious depression in trade, etc., has made us a liberal grant, though less by £100 than last year. This decreased grant, of course, makes it all the more necessary for the income here to be increased. While we have been blessed with an abundant crop, in England it is a serious failure. Let therefore gratitude to God prompt our people to liberal gifts to the Mission cause, so that the falling-off in the English grant, because of their necessities, may be, through our abundance, more than made up.

Notwithstanding the embarrassment of the English Mission Fund, our English friends are still zealously pressing forward in their work. It would have been pleasurable to our friends to read in this report something of their doings, as it would have been to us to record them, but our space is full, and we must ask our friends to see the English Missionary Report and Records and they will find records of the Gospel of Christ triumphant. We cannot, however, refrain from a reference to Fernando-po Mission, which of late has been subjected to great trial. The Spanish Governor of the Island gave permission to the Missionary, Rev. Mr. Holland, to build a fence round the Mission premises at Santa Isabella, and ordered where it should be built, but afterwards expelled the missionary from the country because he built the fence. Of course an arbitrary act of this kind is not much for a Roman Catholic Spanish Governor to do, but it had very distressing consequences. The Rev. R. T. Blackburn, a Missionary at another station, undertook as best he could to supply and oversee both

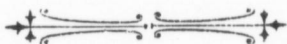

places. This was too much for his physical constitution ; he took brain fever, and in a few days found a martyr's grave. The first Foreign Missionary the Society has lost has been occasioned by the intolerance of Rome, exercised through the Spanish Government. But while the church mourns the loss of so able and zealous a missionary as this servant of Christ was, it is every way likely that good will come out of the evil, and God will make this display of the wrath of men to praise him. The Missionary Society laid the case before the British Government, through whose influence the Spanish Government has been induced to allow the Missionary to return, and he is again engaged in the great work of preaching Christ to the heathen. There can be no doubt about the ultimate results of Christian work in this field of labor.

The world is to be won for Christ ; we as a people wish to do our part in this blessed work ; and let our people remember that this work has in itself a present reward ; there is a blessing in working and giving for the cause of Christ. But let them think of this, also, that when He who is their life shall appear, they also shall appear with him in Glory.
