BILL.

An Act to alter the day on which the Militia shall annually assemble for muster and discipline in Upper Canada.

WHEREAS the day appointed by the Preamble. twenty-eighth Section of the Act regulating the Militia, for the Annual Muster of the said Militia, hath been found inconvenient in Upper Canada, and it is expedient to change the day so appointed: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority Annual muster day changed as to U. C. of the same, That for and notwithstanding anything in the twenty-eighth Section or in any other part of the Act passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled "An Act to repeal certain laws therein mentioned, to provide for the better defence of 9 Vict. c. 28. this Province, and to regulate the Militia thereof," the day on which the first class of Militia shall be assembled in Upper Canada for muster and discipline shall not be the twenty-ninth day of June, but shall 20 be the day of in each year, unless that day be a Sunday or holiday, in which case the next following day not being a Sunday or a holiday, shall be the day for so assembling.
