HINTS TO THE PROFESSION

REGARDING

The New Rules of Practice

IN FORCE JANUARY 1ST, 1896.

Divisions are practically abolished, and all actions shall hereafter be styled "In the High Court of Justice." Rule 1435.

Business which formerly should have been transacted in either the office of the Clerk of Records and Writs, or of the Registrar of the Queen's Bench or Common Pleas Division, shall hereafter be transacted in the *Central Office*. Rule 1399.

All judgments and orders made at any sittings of the High Court for the trial of causes, matters and issues at Toronto, or at any sittings of a Divisional Court, shall be settled by the Senior Registrar (Mr. Holmsted); but upon the consent of the parties the same may be settled by the Registrar in attendance, on the Court making such judgment or order. Rules 1405 (d) and 1409.

An interlocutory injunction may, in cases of emergency, be granted by a local Judge, the same to remain in force not longer than eight days, unless continued by the High Court, and the parties consenting thereto, a motion to continue, vary, dissolve, or otherwise deal with such injunction may also be heard or determined by a local Judge. Rule 1419.

An order for payment out of Court made by the Master in Chambers, or by a local Judge, must be approved by a Judge of the High Court before it is acted upon. Rule 1422.

A Divisional Court of the High Court shall sit every week except during the Long and Christmas vacations, and, beginning on Monday of each week, shall continue from day to day except Saturday, until the business before the Court is disposed of. Rule 1429.

In the County of York writs shall be issued from the *Central Office*, and in other Counties by the Deputy Clerk of the Crown or by the Deputy Registrar, at the option of the plaintiff; or, where there is a local Registrar, then by such local Registrar. Rule 1435.

In foreclosure actions a defendant desiring a sale must, within the time allowed for appearance, file a memorandum to that effect, and must attach thereto a certificate of the Accountant that he has *paid into Court* in the action \$30.00, to meet the expenses of sale. Rule 1441.

An appointment for examination served upon the solicitor for a party seven days before the return day shall be sufficient without personal service of a subpoena on such party; conduct money may be paid or tendered to the solicitor, who must pay it over to his client. It must not be applied on account of solicitor's costs. The old practice of serving a party with a subpoena *may* be adopted if the party examining so desires. Rule 1452.

Chamber appeals need not be set down for argument, and they will come on to be heard as motions; but about the only appeal which can now be heard by a Judge in Chambers is an appeal from a Taxing Officer. See Rule 1490. Rule 1457.

Professional witness fees shall not be allowed by a Taxing Officer unless the trial Judge shall certify that the evidence given by such witness was of an expert or professional character, or was produced on account of the skill or professional knowledge possessed by such witness. Rule 1459.

Exhibits referred to in an affidavit that is filed should not be annexed thereto, and when not so annexed need not be filed. Rule 1461.

Every action shall be tried in the county in which the cause of action arises, if all parties reside in that county; but an order may be made upon the application of either party, and for good cause shown that the action shall be tried in another county. Rule 1463.

Judgments, whether pronounced by the Court or signed by default, shall, where properly signed in Toronto, be signed by or under the direction of the Clerk of the Crown and Pleas, Mr. Jackson. (Mr. Mac-Namara has particular charge of this branch of work, which is conducted in the office formerly occupied by the Registrar of the Common Pleas Div.) Rule 1481.

Every motion to a Divisional Court *against a judgment, or for a new trial*, or by way of appeal from the judgment or order of a Judge of the High Court made at the trial, shall be set down to be heard for the first sittings of a Court after the expiration of one month (in County Court cases 30 days, Rule 1489) from the date of pronouncing judgment. The notice must be a 7 clear days' notice, and must be set down two clear days before the first day of the sittings for which notice is given. Rule 1484.

A motion by way of appeal to a Divisional Court from a Judge sitting in Court *otherwise than at trial* shall be set down to be heard for the first sittings, for which due notice can be served after the expiration of four days from the date of pronouncing the judgment

or order complained of. The notice must be a two clear days' notice, and must be set down two clear days before the first day of the sittings for which notice is given. Rule 1484.

Every notice of motion or appeal to a Divisional Court must set out the grounds of the motion or appeal. Rule 1484.

Security for costs on appeals to the Court of Appeal shall not hereafter be required to be given unless specially ordered by the Court of Appeal, or a Judge thereof. Rule 1487.

Notice of appeal to the Court of Appeal must be served within one month after the judgment complained of, and not less than 7 clear days before the first day of the sittings at which the appeal is to be heard, and the appeal must be set down for the first day of the sittings, commencing after the expiration of one month from the date on which judgment has been signed. Rule 1487.

When an appeal has been properly set down, notice thereof, signed by the Registrar of the Court of Appeal (in County Court appeals, by one of the Registrars of the High Court, Rule 1489), may be directed to the Sheriff, in whose hands any writ of execution may be, under the judgment appealed from, and thereupon execution shall be stayed pending the appeal, unless otherwise ordered. Rule 1487.

Reasons of appeal must be served along with the notice of appeal, and one copy must be filed with the Registrar, and four copies delivered to him when setting down the appeal for the use of the Judges, and the respondent must serve reasons against appeal not later than the day before the first day of the sittings for which the appeal is set down; and he shall also file one copy and deliver four copies to the Registrar for the use of the Judges. Rule 1488.

Printed appeal books shall not hereafter be necessary. Four legible typewritten copies of the judgment complained of, the written opinion, or opinions, of the Judge or Judges by whom the judgment was pronounced, and the stenographer's notes of evidence (including the Judge's charge, if any), shall be delivered to the Registrar along with the reasons of appeal, and the record, exhibits, affidavits, or other papers and documents upon which the judgment complained of proceeded, and which affect the question raised by the appeal. Appeal books may be printed as formerly, but, if so printed without any order or consent, the party printing shall, in any event, bear the extra costs occasioned thereby. Rule 1488.

Court instead of to the Court of Appeal, and notice of the hearing of the appeal, etc., must be served by the appellants *seven* days before the sittings, instead of six, as formerly. Rule 1489.

Appeals from a Judge in Chambers, Master in Chambers, Local Judge, or Local Master shall be to a *Divisional Court*, and these appeals shall have precedence over other cases on the list. The notice of motion must be served within 4 days and be returnable within 10 days after the decision complained of, and must be set down at latest the day before the day when the motion is returnable. Rule 1490.

A bond given for security for costs may be delivered up for cancellation or suit upon consent of the solicitors, without any order. Rule 1499.

The Taxing Officer's discretion is no longer limited in allowing a Counsel fee on argument in the Court of Appeal in High Court cases. Rule 1504.

Owing to the fact that several changes have been made in the form of endorsement of Writs of Summons in mortgage actions, new supplies of these forms should be obtained.

Set down all motions for the Weekly Court, and file papers incidental thereto with Mr. C. O. Strange, in the office formerly occupied by the Registrar of the Q.B.D.

In the published copy of the Rules which came into force, January 1st, 1896, Rule 1560 is so numbered by a misprint; it should be 1510, and should read as follows: "1510. The following Rules are repealed, viz.:—Rules 11-19, inclusive, 22, 23, 24, 190, 216-218, inclusive, 1268, 1305, 649-651, inclusive, 789, 800, 1266, 1277 (a), sub-clause (e), 666 (b), as contained in 1278, 1282-1285, inclusive, 1303, 1304, 1306, and 1356."
