RECIPROcity IN COAL

The Senate Finance Committee Refers the Pop-Gun Bill Back Amended.

Washington, Aug. 20.—Senator Harris (Dem., Tenn.), the acting chairman of the Finance Committee, carried out today the promise which he made at the close of the last session, that the four House bills which he had introduced on the iron and barbed wire, would be reported back from the committee if they were amended.

The Free Sugar bill no longer provides for free sugar, but for an ad valorem duty of 40 per cent, on all sugar, and for a specific duty of two cents a gallon on molasses, testing above 40 and containing 80 degrees, and of one cent on molasses above 60 degrees, omitting all reference to differentials. The Free Coal bill came back with a provision for a duty on all coal imported from countries that levied an import duty on iron or steel.

The Free Iron Ore bill was the only one that came back in its original shape, and what it means is the exposure of blundering on the part of the House of Representatives in its precipitancy had not, as it had intended to do, placed barbed wire on the free list.
