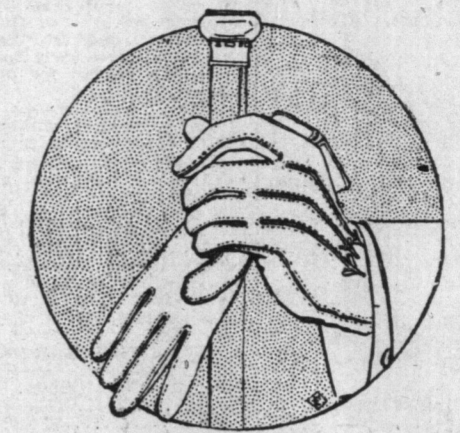
Sheriff Paxton Unable to Make Trip—Barrie to Play Intermediate.

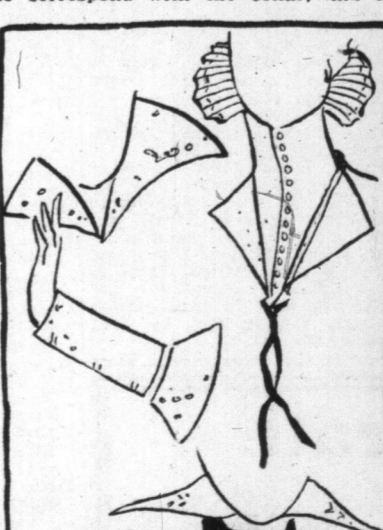
