LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.
FRIDNESDAY, March 20.
The bill to amend an Act to regulate the use of spirituous liquors in St. John was committed, and progress reported.

The bill to amend the Corporation of the City of St. John, to give Prince of Wales street, extending from Duke street to north side of Market Square. He moved an amendment to the amount sought for, \$25,000, to be reduced to \$25,000, for the reason as doubts were entertained not only whether the money was the proper material for pavement, but also whether the amount asked for the pavement was the proper kind of wood.
