

An Act concerning the Inspection of Flour and Meal.

IN amendment of the Act respecting the Inspection of Flour and Pressive.

Meal, chapter forty-seven of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada; Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 5 I. At the end of section eleven of the said recited Act, there shall be Death or added the words, "But in the event of the death or absence of the In-absence of spector, such sworn Assistant or Assistants shall use the brand of such Inspector, until his successor is appointed."
- 2. That portion of the thirteenth section of the said Act which Size of instru 10 regulates the size of the instruments to be used in inspection ments. for proving the contents, shall be amended by substituting therefor the words "(not exceeding five-eights of one inch in depth of diameter, and eleven-sixteenths, in width of diameter within its gauge or bore);" and in the eleventh line of the said section, after the words "to
- 15 be plugged" there shall be added the words, "and such inspection may be made either at the store or warehouse designated by such inspector (subject to the usual storage charges), or at some store or place within the warehouse of limits of the place for which the Inspector be appointed, at the option Inspector or of the owner or possessor of such flour or meal."

11. The second sub-section of the twenty-third section of the said Act is hereby repealed.

12. The twenty-eighth section of the said Act is hereby repealed.

13. All the words in section twenty-nine of the said Act, after the words "deficient in weight" in the seventh line, are hereby repealed.

14. Instead of the penalty of four dollars per barrel imposed by the thirtieth section of the said Act, it is enacted that the penalty shall be 30th section. twenty-five cents per barrel.
