## The Applied Art Building

In the Applied Art Building will be found the exhibits of Photography, Architecture, Graphic and Applied Art. The photographic section includes exhibits by the members of the Toronto Camera Club and the Ontario Photographers' Association. The architectural designs are contributed by the Ontario Association of Architects. The applied art section contains the exhibit of the Canadian Society of Applied Art, an interesting collection of jewelry and bronzes gathered in Great Britain, and several decorative paintings and mural studies from the studios of the New York artists, as well as examples of American jewelry and ceramics. The British exhibit was collected by Mrs. E. Rimbault Dibdin, whose experience, taste and wide acquaintance with the decorative arts of Great Britain have been of the greatest service to the Exhibition for the last few years. In the graphic arts department are exhibited a collection of illustrations contributed by the Associated Sunday Magazines of New York; a group of prints by leading American etchers, whose work is seen in Toronto for the first time this year; several drawings, etchings and lithographs by Belgian artists, and the Canadian section including the exhibits of the members of the Society of Graphic Art, and a number of illustrations loaned by Canadian publishers.
