List of Paintings in the French Basilica

This Church is the oldest in Canada (A. D. 1647). Destroyed by fire during the siege of Quebec (A. D. 1859), His Holiness the POPE PIUS THE NINTH has raised it to the eminent dignity of MINOR BASILICA.

- 1 On the right hand, first pillar.—The Holy Family,—by Blanchard.
- 2 Our Saviour insulted by the soldiers,—by Fleuret.
- 3 Birth of Christ,—a copy of the same painting executed by Annibal Car-rache.

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- 4 In the lateral chapel, on the right, above the altar,—The Flight of Joseph into Egypt,—by Théophile Hamel; the original by Vanloo.
- 5 In the choir on the right,—Our Savior attended to by the angels after the temptation in the desert,—by Restout.
- 6 Above the chief alter.—The Immaculate Conception,—Lebrun's style.
- 7 On the left hand.—St Paul's extacy, by Carlo Marratti.
- 8 In St Ann's chapel,—Miracles of St Ann,—by A Plamondon.
- 9 Coming back to the interior, first pillar.—Our Saviour on the Cross, by Van Dick.
- 10 The Pentecost,—by Vignon.
- 11 The Annunciation,—by Restout.
- 12 In the chapel near the entrance.—The Saviour's Sepulchre and Interment,—Copied by A. Plamondon, from the original by Hutin.

In this Chapel is the Baptistery.—above the altar, stands the statue of our Lady of Pity. The group of the opposite chapel, represents St Joseph's death.

N. B.—The other small paintings placed around the lateral chapels are the Four Stations of our Saviour's Passion.

On application to the sexton, strangers can see the ornaments, gold brocade, &c., &c.

The silver and gold set is composed of 29 different pieces. It has been bought in 1850 at Lyons in France.—The complete purple set, is of 26 different pieces, has also been bought at Lyons in 1850.—The black set is composed of 20 different pieces, bought at Lyons in 1869.—The old set, bearing the shield of Louis XIV, is a gift of that King. It is more than two hundred years old, 22 different pieces.

Seminary Chapel

In this Chapel may be seen the best collection of paintings in America of the french school and by eminent masters

 - 14 St Jerome writing.—by J. B. Champagne, 1643-1688.
- The shrine on the right of the chief altar contains the relics of St Clement martyr.; that on the left, the relics of St Modestus martyr.
The funeral marble on the right of

the main altar was erected in honor of the Most Reverend François de Montmorency Laval, first bishop of Quebec and founder of the Seminary of Quebec, who died on the 6th of May 1708.

The other marble on the left, was erected in honor of the Very Reverend L.-J. Casault, Vicar General, founder of Laval University, who died on the 6th of May 1862.

Under the central altar of the right lateral Chapel, is lying the body of St Laureatus, martyr of St Zeno's military Legion in Rome.

The wooden bust of the Apostle St Paul, on the left of the same altar, by Giovanni Anderlini, contains a link of St Paul's chain during his captivity in Rome.

On the right, the bust of St Francis de Sales, by the same author, contains a large parcel of a rib of this holy bishop and doctor.

The Chapel was erected about a century ago.

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
