GENERAL BY-LAW

Municipal Government of the Township of Elma.

WHEREAS, it is expedient to provide by one general By-law for the government of the municipality of the Township of Elma, in the County of Perth, Ontario; and whereas the Municipal Corporation of the said Township of Elma, under and by virtue of the authority vested in it by the Municipal Institutions Act of Ontario enacted as follows...

TOWNSHIP OFFICERS' LIABILITY TO SUE

1. Any person appointed to any office by the Municipal Council of the Township of Elma, who shall refuse or neglect to make and subscribe the declaration prescribed by law, within twenty days after being notified, shall forfeit and pay to the Township Treasurer a sum not exceeding five dollars...

TOWNSHIP OFFICERS' RESPONSIBILITY, ETC.

1. Any pathmaster or other Township Officer who shall refuse or neglect to preserve in safe keeping the Township of Elma, in the County of Perth, Ontario, or who shall refuse to deliver the same to his successor in office, on demand; or shall neglect or refuse to fulfill any duty lawfully imposed on him by any By-law or resolution of the Corporation passed in Council, shall be liable to a penalty of not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars...

SUPPLEMENTARY DUTIES OF COLLECTOR

1. The Collector or Collectors of the Township of Elma shall, in addition to the duties imposed on such officers by statute, be required in all cases, to give to each party who pays his taxes, a proper receipt therefor, whether such receipt be demanded or not...

ANIMALS PROHIBITED FROM RUNNING AT LARGE

1. A lawful fence shall, in the case of rail fences, consist of not less than seven rails in each panel, and shall be at least five feet high, and locked or staked in the middle or at the corners of each panel, with no space greater than four inches wide below the fourth rail...

DOGS AND MAD DOGS

1. Any dog found running at large within the Township of Elma on the premises of the owner or harbinger, or on any public road, shall be liable to a penalty of not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars...

STATUTE LABOR AND DUTIES OF PATHMASTERS

1. It shall be the duty of each Pathmaster, to superintend the expenditure of all statute labor placed at his disposal by the Township Council, and by means thereof to keep in repair the roads and bridges within the limits of his division...

BRIDGES AND CROSSINGS-PRESERVATION OF

1. Any person or persons who shall willfully, maliciously or negligently set fire to any bridge, or any structure in the immediate vicinity of any public bridge or crossing, or destroy or damage, or by any means unlawfully remove or injure any public bridge or crossing within the Township of Elma, shall be liable to a penalty of not less than ten dollars...

PROHIBIT VARIOUS EXHIBITIONS WITHOUT LICENSE

1. It shall not be lawful for any person or persons to exhibit with figures, wild animals, puppet shows, wire dancing, circus riding, or any other idle acts, or tests, which common showmen, circuses, mountebanks or jugglers usually exhibit, practice or perform, on any public road or highway, or on any land or premises, or to exhibit as hereinafter provided, and any person or persons exhibiting or performing without such license shall forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding fifty dollars...

AUTHORIZE JUSTICES OF THE PEACE TO IMPOSE AND COLLECT FINES AND PENALTIES IMPOSED BY BY-LAWS OF THIS MUNICIPALITY, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF SUCH FINES AND PENALTIES WHEN SO COLLECTED.

Be enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Elma, that it is hereby enacted: 1. All persons committing any offence against any of the By-laws of this Municipality, for the punishment of which no other provision was made, may be proceeded against by any Justice of the Peace for the County of Perth, Ontario, having jurisdiction in this Township, by such Justice or Justices tried, convicted, and punished, as provided by such By-law or By-laws...

SPRING STOCK

When under the foregoing provisions any pecuniary penalty shall be collected, the collector thereof, in the case of whom such penalty has been paid, shall pay one half the sum of such penalty to the informer, or prosecutor, and the other half to the Treasurer of the Township of Elma. Provided that when the prosecutor is in default of the Township of Elma, the whole of the penalty recovered shall be paid to the Treasurer of the Municipality.

4. In case of any person travelling or being upon any highway in this township, in charge of a vehicle drawn by one or more horses, or one or more other animals, meet another vehicle drawn as aforesaid, he shall turn out to the right from the centre of the road, allowing to the vehicle so met one half of the road.

5. In case of any person travelling or being upon any highway in charge of a vehicle as aforesaid, or on horseback, he shall be liable to a penalty of not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars, if he is found to be in violation of any of the provisions of this By-law.

6. In case of one vehicle being met or overtaken by another, if by reason of the extreme weight of the load on either of the vehicles so meeting, or on the vehicle so overtaken, the driver finds it impracticable to turn out as aforesaid, he shall immediately stop, and if necessary for the safety of the other vehicle, and if required to do so he shall assist the person in charge thereof to pass without damage.

7. In case any person in charge of a vehicle or of a horse or other animal used as the means of conveyance, travelling or being on any highway as aforesaid, be through drunkenness, unable to drive or ride the same with safety to other persons travelling on or being upon the highway, he shall incur the penalties imposed for an infringement of this By-law.

8. Every person travelling on any highway in this township with a sleigh, sled, cutter, or carriage, drawn by a horse or mule, shall have at least two bells attached to the harness.

9. Any person offending against the now statutory provisions of this By-law, shall incur the penalties imposed for violating any By-laws of this Municipality, under section No. XIII.

2. What are commonly called "brush" fences shall not be lawful, however secure they may be, and the sufficiency of any other description of fence shall be determined by the Justices of the Peace, in the majority of the Fence viewers lawfully called on to inspect the same.

3. No cattle which can be proved on the evidence of two credible disinterested witnesses to be in the habit of throwing fences, no horses, bills, sheep or pigs, shall be allowed to run at large within the Township of Elma.

4. Any animal of the above description so unlawfully running at large, shall be liable to a penalty of not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars, and the owner thereof, or any slutt running at large who is not otherwise destroyed by any person, shall be liable to a penalty of not less than one dollar.

5. Any person owning or harboring any dog known or suspected to have been bitten by any mad dog, or to be in a secure and sufficient manner such dog, as soon as it becomes known to him, or complaint thereof is made to him, under a penalty of not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars, to cause the dog to be destroyed, or to have it destroyed, may plead these provisions in justification thereof.

6. In case the animal restrained is a horse, bull, ox, cow, sheep, goat, pig, or any other cattle, and if the same is restrained by the Township for straying within its premises, such person, instead of delivering the animal to a Pound-keeper, may retain the animal in his own possession, provided he makes no claim for damages done by the animal, and daily gives the notice hereinafter in this case required of him.

7. If the owner is known to him, he shall forthwith give the owner notice in writing of his having taken up the animal, and retaining possession of the animal, such person shall, within forty-eight hours, deliver to the Municipal Clerk, a notice in writing of having taken up the animal, and containing a description of the color, age and natural or artificial marks of the animal.

8. The Municipal Clerk, on receiving this notice, shall forthwith enter a copy thereof in a book to be kept by him for that purpose, and shall post the notice on the door of his office, and continue the same posted for at least one week, unless the animal is sooner claimed by the owner.

9. If the owner of any number of animals, taken up at the same time be of the value of ten dollars or more, the distrainer shall cause a copy of the notice to be inserted in the nearest newspaper published in the County, and to be continued therein once a week for three successive weeks.

10. In case an animal be impounded, notice for the sale thereof shall be given by the Pound-keeper or the person who impounded the animal within forty-eight hours after the date of impounding, but no pig or poultry shall be sold till after the expiration of three days after the date of their clear days from the time of impounding the same.

11. If the animal be not impounded, but is retained in the possession of the party restraining the same, if the animal be a pig, goat or sheep, the notice for the sale thereof shall be given one month; and if the animal is a horse or other cattle, the notices shall not be given for two months after the animal is taken up.

12. The notices of sale may be written or printed, and shall be affixed and continued for three clear days in three public places in the Municipality, and shall specify the time and place at which the animal shall be publicly sold; if not sooner replaced or reclaimed by the owner, or someone acting on his behalf, the animal shall be sold, and the amount of the injury (if any) claimed or decided to have been committed by the animal to the property of the person who distrained, together with the lawful fees and charges of the Pound-keeper, and also the Fence-viewers (if any), and the expenses of the animal's keeping.

13. Every Pound-keeper and every person who impounds or confines, or causes to be impounded or confined, any animal in any common pound, or in any open or closed pound, or in any enclosed place, shall daily furnish the animal with good and sufficient food, water and shelter, during the whole time that such animal continues impounded or confined.

14. In case any person who furnishes the animal with food, water and shelter, may recover the value thereof from the owner of the animal, and also a reasonable allowance for his time, trouble and attendance in the premises.

15. The value or allowance as aforesaid may be recovered, with costs, by summary proceeding before any Justice of the Peace within whose jurisdiction the animal was impounded, in like manner as fines, penalties or forfeitures for the breach of any By-law of the Municipality may be recovered by the same Justice of the Peace.

16. The Pound-keeper, or person so entrusted to proceed, may, instead of proceeding as aforesaid, enforce the payment of the amount of such fine, penalty or forfeiture, by the same Justice of the Peace, or by any other Justice of the Peace, in the Township of Elma, the whole of the penalty recovered shall be paid to the Treasurer of the Municipality.
