a half) per barrel cheaper than the United Staces or any other part of the World, making quite a laizse save to our people. The agreement referred to above gave New-

Flcur (while Canada was using flour not so white, , gave Newfoundland assurance of full
surplies, and rescinded the tax of two dollars which had been placed on Flour exported from Nfld. Food Control Board ${ }^{6}$
