A BONANZA FOR THE PROMOTERS.

The consummation of the Ontario and Rainy River Railway deal with the Government could not have occurred at more opportune moment.

The project will yield Messrs. Mann and Mackenzie as big profits as anything they or either of them have yet struck.

Iron is king at the present moment, and the Ontario and Rainy River iron country that the Rainy River Railway runs.

Not only will the new railway have a big traffic in iron ore but the promoters of the railway are heavily interested in iron properties.

While the railway project has been simmering during the past few years, those who were interested in it were quietly picking up the best locations.

The Ontario and Rainy River railway will be a paying business from the start. It will make millions for the promoters.

And that at no distant date, but almost immediately. As usual, when any valuable asset is discovered in Canada, the Americans are on hand preparing to carry it off.

They have cornered most of the gold of the Yukon, they possess the output of our nickel mines, they are devastating our spruce forests.

They are in possession of Niagara Falls. Now they have invaded the New Ontario iron country and are only awaiting the opening of the new railway to carry off the iron.

There is no duty on such iron ore as is imported into the United States, and subsequently exported therefrom.

A despatch from Duluth states that it is the intention of the American iron men to send an enormous supply of iron ore from New Ontario to build up an export trade in steel.

They are looking to Canada to furnish them with the raw materials for their great industry.

They are to be paid for the iron ore they have just closed an option for the fee to four miles of the strike of the Atholken range, paying \$10,000 cash at a local in this city.

And agreeing to pay \$300,000 more at the completion of their investigations. In a few weeks they will have their men at work test-pitting and examining the ore.

They will not do prospecting and exploration, for that is scarcely necessary where the iron ore rises 100 feet above the surrounding soil, and can be traced for thousands of feet, and at intervals for many miles, but will examine the ore to see whether or not the rich assays of the surface ore hold out, and, if so, they will begin mining immediately.

Assays made at various times by the Canadian Geological Survey, the Minnesota Iron Company, Carnegie & Co., and others, show this ore to be from 64 to 68 in iron, and as low as .080 in phosphorus.

It is said that there are 2,000,000 tons of ore in sight at the present time, without one stroke of development work ever having been done.

Recent reports of experts say that the ore may be mined and put on cars at from 40 to 50 cents a ton. It can be dropped by side cuts directly into cars on tracks beside the outcrops.

The Lake Superior ore is away ahead of the capacity of the ore boats for handling the traffic. The shipment of ore from Duluth will aggregate 7,400,000 tons for the season, an increase of 1,000,000 tons over last year.

Messrs. Mann and Mackenzie have completed their assays of the most favorable samples. An immense traffic is already awaiting the opening of the railway.
