An Act to change the name of the Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Bytown.

WHEREAS by the Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in Preamble.
 the Session of Parliament held in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled "An Act to incorporate the Roman Catholic Archbishop and Bishops in each Diocese in Lower Canada," The Right
 5 Reverend Joseph Eugène Bruno Gingues, Roman Catholic Bishop of Bytown, and his successors, being Bishops in communion with the Church of Rome, were declared to be a body corporate by the name of "The Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Bytown:" And where-
 as since the passing of the said Act, the name of the Town of Bytown
 10 aforesaid has, by Act of Parliament, been changed into and is known by the name of the City of Ottawa; and in consequence the said Joseph Eugène Bruno Gingues hath petitioned that the name of the said corporation be changed, and that the said corporation be hereafter known by the name of "The Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of
 15 Ottawa," and it is desirable to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

I. From and after the passing of this Act, the Corporation incorporated by the Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the 20 Session of Parliament held in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, 12 Vic., Cap intituled "An Act to incorporate the Roman Catholic Archbishop and Bishops in each Diocese in Lower Canada," by the name of "The Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Bytown" shall be called and known by the name of "The Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of
 25 Ottawa," anything in the said Act, or any other Act or Law, to the contrary, notwithstanding: Provided always, that such change of name shall not be construed to make the said corporation a new corporation, or to impair or alter the effect of any Act relating to the said corporation, or of any instrument or proceeding to or in which the said corporation by its former name may be, or may have been a party, or in any wise concerned or interested, but the same shall have full force and effect, and shall apply to and may be continued with respect to the said corporation by the name hereby assigned to it.

II. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.]

Public Act.

The corporation incorporated by Act 12 Vic., Cap 126, by the name of "The R. C. E. Corporation of Bytown," hereafter to be called by the name of "The R. C. E. Corporation of Ottawa." Proviso.
