To-Day's Elections Across the Line. Elections are to be held to-day in eleven States of the American Union. In two of the States, New York and Ohio, the principal interest centres, and it is not generally believed that in either of them there will be a reversal of the usual order of things political. In New York, which was carried by the Republicans in the presidential election of November, 1888, although the rising governor (Hill) is a Democrat, it is believed the chances of Flower, the only Democrat who has sufficient weight to ensure his election, more especially as the influence of the "bar" and of Tammany's control of the city government is thrown in for the Democratic candidate.

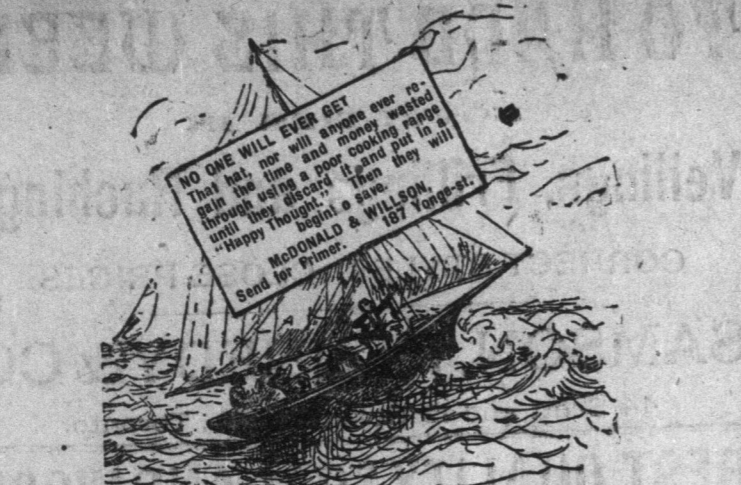

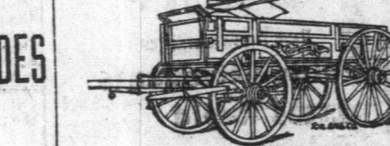
