FIRST DESPATCH.

SAINT JOHN, Feb. 23

The election to-day caused a good deal of excitement; but no noteworthy incidents occurred.

Both friends and opponents of Canada Temperance Act worked vigorously, and every effort was made to poll a full vote.

During the day the greatest uncertainty prevailed. The vote stood 1070 for, 1073 against the act.
