That was a strong deposition—from the Perry Sound district—that inspired Mr. Mowat yesterday. And the deposition had a strong case to present, we should say one of the strongest that ever was presented for provincial aid to a railway.

During his latest interview with a Scotch delegation Mr. Mowat expressed his surprise that municipalities which had exercised the act should have in so many instances elected revers and councillors in-favorable to the enforcement. The delegates did not attempt to explain this apparent mystery, although it is quite capable of explanation.

This is a development which astonishes and annoys our friends across the border, and justifies the confidence which the great majority of Canadians repose in the future of their new territories. The southwestern ranchers are constrained to admit that their methods will have to be revolutionized. Their herds must be reduced to such proportions that they can receive more care in winter than is now given them.

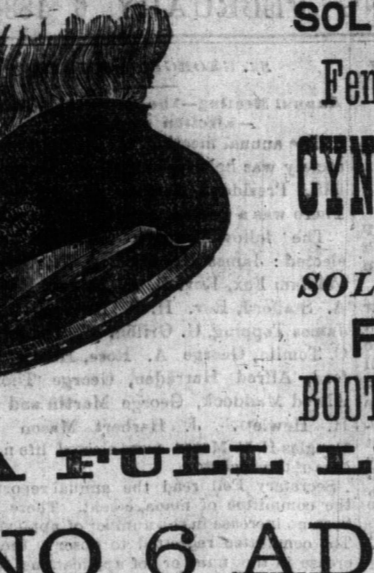
