An Exhibition of the Queen's County Agricultural Society

Will be held in the Temperance Hall, New Jerusalem, on WEDNESDAY, the 17th of October, 1877, at 10 o'clock, a. m.

Previous to which all articles intended for competition must be entered with the Secretary, as there will be no entries made on that day. All articles for exhibition, except stock, must be delivered at the Hall the day previous to the Exhibition, into the charge of the Committee, in order that they may be properly arranged for exhibition.

No person, or persons, will be allowed to exhibit any article for competition that does not belong to them.

Any person, or persons, so doing will forfeit their right to any premiums to which they might otherwise be entitled. No person, or persons, will be allowed to enter for competition more than one specimen of any article in any section of this list, (except in Class 1st,) unless the additional article be of a distinct name, variety, or pattern from the first.

No person shall be allowed to enter any article, or animal, for competition, unless he or she, or the head of the family, or house to which he or she belongs, has the name entered as a member on the Treasurer's book, and entrance fee paid two months before this Exhibition.

If it be ascertained that any exhibitor has intentionally made, or caused to be made, any false statement in regard to any animal, or article, exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the Judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall forfeit his or her right to any premiums to which he or she might otherwise be entitled.

All articles in Classes 4 and 5 must be manufactured since the 25th of last October.

Any animal, or article, entered for exhibition in one Class cannot compete for a premium in any other. The Judges will be selected from different sections of the country, but will not be made public until the Exhibition. Persons from other Counties may compete in Classes 3 and 4 by paying the entrance fee, as above mentioned.

DIRECTIONS TO BE OBSERVED BY THE JUDGES:

The Judges are particularly requested not to give encouragement to over-fed animals in the breeding classes.

When articles, or animals, are not deemed worthy of a premium, the Judges will refuse to award one.

If there is any animal, or article, with which there is no competition, it shall not receive the first premium on that account, but the Judges may give it the one its merits demands.

Agricultural produce will be mostly judged by appearance, and weights will be used only when the Judges cannot decide without them.

There will be no prize awarded to any machine, or article, in Class 3rd, unless there is some new improvement for the old ones to compete with.
