WAS WON LAST YEAR AT SEAGIRT Will Not Send Team to Ireland—Paper on Association's Policy.

New York, Jan. 11.—Directors of the National Rifle Association held to-night an important meeting in this city. Brig. Gen. Bird W. Spencer presided.

A resolution was passed favoring the sending of a team to Canada during the year in an attempt to regain possession of the Palma Trophy, won by the riflemen from over the border last September.

Questions bearing upon the future policy and welfare of the association were discussed, among which were the following: Close relations between the association and government and details of the bill to be presented to Congress.
