At a protracted meeting in B. Maine, in 1851,

power and extent throughout New England,

above related, referring to the same in my own
pulpit in W., I quoted the words of the one who

in the congregation, who was a wife and a mother,
of some thirty years of age, for she said
to a friend, that at once she felt those billows
rolling over her soul, adding that she never be-
fore felt as if she had a soul. Learning her
husband was absent at sea, I found her
walking her room in her most mental agony.
I immediately went to see her, and she said,
"Sir, what shall I do? what shall I do? I
would give worlds for religion if I might, but
I have it not."
"You may have it without money and with-
out price, for Christ says, 'Come unto me all ye
that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give
you rest.' Let us now kneel down on this spot,
confess our sins, and ask God for Christ's sake,
to pardon and save us. I do not ask you to
pray with me, but that you will understand
to let your heart go out to God, in words I
may use in your behalf."
"Sir," she replied, "I wish you would pray
for me, but I cannot kneel down with you, sir,
this is too much, too humiliating."
"Good-by, madam," was my reply. I de-
parted, thinking it best to leave her to her own
reflections. Passing out of her house, she
caught me to pray for her. I assured her she
must pray for herself, or she would never find
forgiveness.
Some days after a lady living across the street
informed me that her distressed neighbor had
said, referring to myself, "O, if the pastor
would come back and see me, how gladly would
I kneel down with him, while he might pray for
me." So bowed down she was with a sense of
her guilt and rain that she neglected to take care
of her little children; the lady alluded to look-
ing after and providing for them. Advised of her
dilemma as to how to me in prayer, I suggested
myself, and found her reduced, from mental agony,
to a mere shivering—the personification of im-
punity. Again I proposed that she should kneel
in prayer. But unwillingly she was as ever, yet
most earnestly begged me to pray for her.
"Yes, my dear madam," I said, "I will try to
pray for you, if you will bow down with me.
I do not ask you to pray with me, but that you
understand to pour out your soul to God in words
