**Arab's Officers Surrendering-Capture of**

LONDON, Aug. 24.-A correspondent of  
the News at Ismailia says the entire expedi-  
tion is in magnificent health, admirably  
equipped and sound in every respect. I  
have no hesitation in saying it would be  
impossible for any country in the world to  
send abroad a better little army.

The garrisons have a letter. It was a splendid  
sight to see their magnificent horses dis-  
embarked, but it is not so much the horses  
that the animals are hardly suited to bear the  
scorching heat of the climate.

**THE ENEMY AT ISMAILIA.**  
The Telegraph's Ismailia correspondent  
says: The enemy is reported in force ten  
miles off. Occasionally they attack our  
pickets, but retire directly we advance.  
Our line extends over a mile and a half  
beyond Ismailia with advanced pickets and  
outposts and infantry and cavalry. The  
Duke of Connaught with a brigade of  
guards is stationed to the left of Ismailia.
