STRENGTH OF THE NAVIES

Uncle Sam Would Easily Blow the Spaniards Out of the Water.

Such is the opinion of British shipbuilders who have been interviewed on the subject. The same sentiment is shared by the British navy.

New York, March 3.-The subject of the relative strength of Spain and the United States is contained in a cable from London to The World:

"The United States will have every town on the Spanish coast blown to atoms, I am ready to wager, a month after the beginning of hostilities," said William Allan, M.P., to the correspondent.

Mr. Allan represents the Gathcabe division in the House of Commons, is one of the largest shipbuilders of the Tyne and is an acknowledged high authority on naval questions.

"The correspondent had asked him if there is any likelihood that Spain can buy war vessels now building in British yards from the Government which ordered them."

"I have always expressed in the House of Commons, as you know, my admiration for American warships. I challenged our Government to test the new cruiser Powerful by sending her across the Atlantic at full speed, as the United States Government had sent the Columbia, but our Government declined."

"I consider that America has some of the finest ships afloat, and I know the American sailors to be as good as any in the world."

"Why Spain is a retrograde a moribund nation. If she should equip up all the warships available all over the world she could not give the United States cause for an instant's consideration."

"I believe in the grit, tenacity and fighting capacity of the Anglo-Saxons, but I believe in the Spanish navy as well."

"I have never believed that the United States would employ all their influence to establish a republic there."

"I don't know of any for Chili, but Argentina has three under construction. Argentina won't sell for some torpedo catchers were being constructed for Argentina, the latter declined to sell."

"Spain has four torpedo catchers, about 220 feet long each, and with a speed of 28 knots, on the stocks in Clyde. They are not yet delivered, as the Spanish Government will place an embargo on all the war vessels being constructed, and not one would be permitted to leave our shores, except to go to some power other than the belligerents. If our authorities suspected that ordinary steamers were being fitted for use in any way by either belligerent they would be stopped in the same way."

"Inquiries by the correspondent at Yarrow torpedo boat works, Blackwall, elicited the statement that the firm is building four torpedo catchers for Japan and four for Austria. Neither power would sell the ships to Spain."

At the Thames Shipbuilding Company's works, where the largest and most powerful line battleship ever built is in course of construction for Japan, the manager said: "We have nothing Spain could purchase, as we are building only two line battleships, one for our own Government, the other for Japan. If Spain is looking out for ships, her agents have not been inquiring on the Thames as yet."

TO MANILA-TO NEW YORK.

Spanish Paper Says if the Yankees Attack Manila Spain Will Retaliate on New York.

Madrid, March 3.-The public is much excited over the report of the rescue of a squadron of U.S. warships at Hong Kong, as it is presumed the vessels intend to threaten Manila, the capital of the Philippine Islands, in the event of war between the United States and Spain. The Imparcial, a Spanish paper headed "To Manila, to New York," quoted an unnamed personage who says: "The presence of the warships at Hong Kong is only a warning of the danger which the United States is about to have added. But America has not so many warships as we want such bold action. If the Yankees go to the Philippines, the Spaniards will go to New York."
