Montreal, Sept. 6.—(Special).—The news that Rev. Dr. William I. Mills had been elected Coadjutor-Bishop of Ontario has given great satisfaction here, where he has lived so long. In a conversation to-day he expressed his surprise at the news, and said that he had been surprised to find that the Diocese of Ontario was one of the dioceses of the metropolitan province, in which he had been so long.
