THE FEDERAL SITUATION

The outstanding fact of the correspondence between Sir Robert Borden and Sir Wilfrid Laurier is that the prime minister was not seeking to avoid the turmoil of an election, but intended to appeal to the people as soon as he had succeeded in getting the Liberal leader's consent to a policy of conscription which would practically apply only to men.

THE UGLY FACTS REVEALED

The capital and current debt of New Brunswick is over \$1,000,000. Add the obligations which must be met and it is over \$20,000,000. The estimated revenue of the province for this year is \$1,564,865. Out of this the annual interest charge of \$680,500 must be paid.

Today's account of the British victory at Messines makes it clear that a remarkable success was won with a far smaller casualty list than in former drives.

The work of the artillery was marvellous, and the mine explosions which preceded the attack were the most terrific of any since the war began. The Germans were utterly unable to hold their ground in face of the torrents of death poured upon them with relentless and sustained fury.

Ontario is to employ at least six thousand men in building roads after the war, according to an announcement by W. A. McLean, deputy minister of highways.

The prohibition of betting on Canadian race tracks till after the war will probably be continued in time of peace. It will be no more justifiable than now, and while it serves no useful purpose it does much harm.

Montreal, June 7—With a huge Union Jack stretched beneath the dais occupied by the moderator, Rev. Dr. John Neil of Toronto, the Presbyterian general assembly began its business deliberations in Eskine church this morning. Rev. Dr. Robert Campbell and Rev. Dr. John Somerville reported that the presbyteries had voted in the majority approving of the placing of the names of retired ministers on the presbytery rolls; re-making the presbytery court of an equal number of ministers and elders, and re-ordained assistant ministers being made members of presbytery. The vote on a suggested reduction in the representation in the general assembly was against reduction.

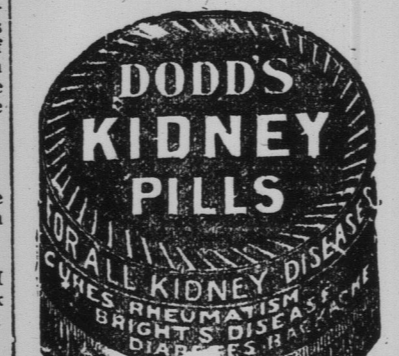
