RE-MARRIAGE AFTER DIVORCE.

An Interesting Discussion in the Protestant Episcopal Church.

At Monday's meeting of the Provincial Synod the following canon was moved by Rev. Canon Partridge, D. D.: "No clergyman of the Protestant Episcopal Church shall solemnize marriage in any case where there is a divorced wife or husband of either party still living."

Canon Partridge spoke at some length, and contended that the law of the church was in favor of the canon proposed. The marriage service of the church read "Till death do us part." What was the meaning of these words, repeated by the contracting parties? They meant that it was not in the province of any clergyman to solemnize any man or woman who had been divorced by a court of law. If they passed the canon before them it would have great moral weight and they would find that in the future men and women would no longer seek for divorce to get a divorce.

Hon. D. L. Hamilton had a strong opinion that it was inadvisable to pass any such canon which was in direct opposition to that passed by the Synod at the Lambeth conference. He then passed a motion and conservative course, which the Church of England had always done. When there was a doubt in the mind of the Church and the nation, then the parties accused should unconditionally have the benefit of the doubt.

The first business yesterday after the minutes were read was the appointment by the lower house of a committee to consider the question of re-marriage after divorce. The committee consisted of Canon Partridge, Dr. Carey, Archbishop Ross, Rev. R. Harris, St. John O. Allen, Hon. D. L. Hamilton, George W. W. Jenkins and Walker. G. O. The upper house appointed the bishop of the Diocese of Fredericton as the same committee.
