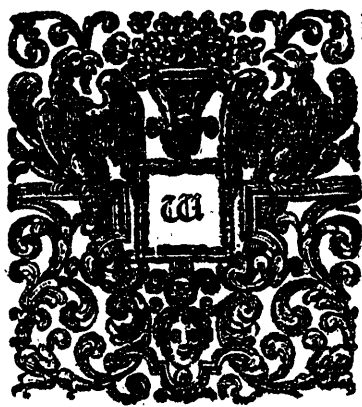

C A P. XLII.

An Act to continue an Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for importing Salt from *Europe*, into the Province of *Quebec* in *America*, for a limited Time.



WHEREAS the Law herein after Preamble. mentioned, which hath by Experience been found useful and beneficial, is near expiring: May it therefore please Your Majesty, that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That an Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for importing Salt from Europe into the Province of Quebec in America, for a limited Time, which was to continue in force from the Twenty fourth Day of June, One thousand seven Act of 4 Geo. III. hundred
