

## (PRIVATE BILL.)

## BILL.

An Act to incorporate a High School at Compton, to be called the Compton High School.

Received and read, first time, Friday, 9th March, 1860. Second reading, Wednesday, 14th March, 1860.

An Act to incorporate a High School at Compton, to be called the Compton High School.

WHEREAS Arba Stimson, James Doak, W. R. Doak, R. Rugg, and Preamble, R. S. Mayor, all of the Township of Compton, Esquires, have, by their petitition, prayed that a High School may be incorporated in the Township and Village of Compton, and it is expedient to incorporate the 5 same; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:-

I. Arba Stimson, James Doak, W. R. Doak, R. Rugg, and R. S. Mayor, and all other persons, who may, by virtue of this Act, replace or be united with them, shall be and are hereby constituted a body politic 10 and corporate, under the name of the Compton High School, and shall by that name have perpetual succession and a common seal, with power to alter, renew or change such seal at pleasure, and power to sue and be sued in all Courts of law or equity; And shall have power at all times hereafter to purchase, acquire, hold, possess, and enjoy such lands 15 and tenements as may be necessary for the actual use and occupation of the said High School, and the same to sell, alienate and dispose of, and others in their stead to purchase, acquire, and hold for the use and purposes aforesaid.
