Note:— THE Accounts of this Colony have been made up on the 20th October in each year.

The Revenue has been appropriated in part payment of various Colonial Disbursements to a much larger amount, incurred by the Governor, with the sanction of His Majesty's Secretary of State, the Balance being provided for by Advances from the Military Chest on the station.

The Revenue derived from the Crown Lands is collected by the Governor's Secretary, who receives an allowance of 5 per cent on the sums collected. The License Duties, and the Fees and Fines, are received and accounted for by the High Sheriff of the District of St. John's.
