The Department of External Affairs today announced the following programme for the visit to Canada of Mr. Robert Schuman, Foreign Minister of France:

- A.M. 8.00 Departure from La Guardia airport, New York, in Canadian Government aircraft, accompanied by the Hon. Paul Martin, Minister of National Health and Welfare.
 - 9.45 Mr. Schuman arrives at Rockcliffe by air from New York, and proceeds to the French Embassy.
 - 10.50 Mr. Schuman lays a wreath at the National War Memorial.
 - 11.00 Call on the Rt. Hon. Thibaudeau Rinfret, Deputy Governor General of Canada, at the Supreme Court Building.
 - 11.30 Call on the Prime Minister of Canada at the East Block.
- P.M. 1.15 Luncheon by the Prime Minister at the Country Club.
 - 3.00 Call on the Rt. Hon. W. L. Mackenzie King at Laurier House.
 - 4.00 Call on the Rt. Hon. C. D. Howe, Minister of Trade and Commerce.
 - 5.00 Call on Monseigneur Vachon, Archbishop of Ottawa, at the Archbishop's palace.
 - 5.30 Mr. Schuman will receive an honorary degree conferred by the University of Ottawa.
 - 6.30 Press conference at the French Embassy, 42 Sussex Street.
 - 8.00 Dinner by the Ambassador of France, His Excellency Hubert Guerin, at the French Embassy.
 - 10.00 Reception at the Embassy.
