PROCEEDINGS OF THE

ANNUAL MEETING.

The Anniversary of the Society was held on Sunday and Monday, June 10th and 11th, in the Bible Christian Church, Exeter. On Sunday two Sermons were preached; in the morning, by Bro. S. Jolliffe, and in the evening, by Bro. C. Barker. In the afternoon a public service was held in connection with the Sabbath School; addresses were delivered by Bros W. Kenner and H. J. Nott. On Monday, at 2:30 p. m., the public meeting was held. Bro. W. Jolliffe, President of the Conference, occupied the chair. The Secretary, Bro. J. Harris, read the report, when the following resolution was moved by Bro. W. Kenner, and seconded by Bro. R. T. Courtice:

That the Report, an abstract of which has been read, be adopted, and published under the direction of the Missionary Committee. We also desire to record our appreciation of the efforts of the friends of the Society who, notwithstanding the general monetary depression, have placed our receipts above any previous year; and we also gratefully recognize the work of the Collectors who have so largely aided us in advancing the income of the Society

The meeting then adjourned for tea. At the adjourned meeting, J. Hull, Esq., presided; Bro. J. Kenner moved, and Bro. W. Hooper seconded:

That, our hearts are greatly cheered by the reports of revivals from almost all our Mission fields. The Lord has been pleased to own and bless our labors during the year. There is an increase of 180 members over last year, while the receipts are \$632.68 more than a year ago; five new churches have been built, and the congregations have considerably increased. We will therefore give Praise to our God, and resolve, that in the name of the Lord, we will still lift up our banners.

Bro. W. Ayers moved, and Bro. E. Roberts seconded: That, feeling that God has given us a work to do in advancing his kingdom, and encouraged by the success of the past: We resolve to consecrate all our powers to God, and his cause; to trust in God's promises, and seek his Divine aid.

REPORT.

"And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in Heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you; and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world."—Matt. xxviii. 18-20.

Thus spake Jesus to his disciples, when He gave them the commission to go forth, preaching repentance and remission of sins to the world. This commission is as wide as the world, and universal as man, and is as binding on the followers of Christ now, as on the Disciples then. Church must not cease teaching until all the nations, " from the river unto the ends of the earth," are found sitting at the feet of Jesus. We must not set about this work with indifference and coldness of heart, but summon all the love and enthusiasm of our nature, and earnestly strive to spread the knowledge of Christ among men. The success and triumphs of the past, the opening and inviting fields of the present time, and immortal souls perishing for lack of knowledge, all unite in urging the disciples of Christ to present and active effort to save souls: to cry aloud and spare not, and lift up their voice like a trumpet.

The principles of the Gospel of Christ, incorporated in human life, are the most potent and soul-inspiring powers that men have known. By faith in Christ, men are connected with the Deity, and hold personal fellowship with the Eternal Father, thus securing the mighty aid of the Holy Spirit, for it is God that worketh in us to "will and to do." Where is now the boasted civilization of Egypt, the philosophy and culture of Greece, the prowess of ancient Rome, the wisdom of the Persian Magi, and the British Druids? All these originating with men, were inherently weak and unable to permanently elevate human character, and have passed away, as all man-made systems must. What has given the European nations, and the Anglo Saxon race. such a preeminence upon the earth as they now enjoy? A few centuries ago, the Gospel of Christ found them sunk in savage barbarism, and subjected to all manner of degrading Pagan worship; but by the power of Christ and His Church, they have been elevated to the position they now enjoy; and although in the midst of this great work, Popery attempted to bind men's consciences, dwarf their intellects. and secure their allegiance to human authority, the Divine power that accompanied this Christianity, broke the fetters, removed the obstructions with which men attempted to arrest its onward march, and taught men to hold diret and personal intercourse with God; and now the Protestant Christian nations occupy the most prominent and influential positions among men, both morally and intellectually.

The obstacles to the carrying out of this commission are such that human agency in itself is insufficient to overcome, and the power and influence of the Holy Ghost are needed to baptise and inspire the Church in her work. On the day of Pentecost, and in the early history of Christianity, God gave the Church practical examples of how this mission work is to be carried on, and the aid He gives men, when engaged in leading the nations to the Saviour. We are to be co-workers with God and shall succeed only as we seek, and obtain the influences of the Holy Spirit.

The Bible Christian Missionary Society originated in an intense desire to comply with the Saviour's command, to teach all nations; its founders, influenced by this all-pervading passion to save souls, went forth directing men "to the Lamb of God who taketh away the sins of the world." The

Lord owned and abundantly blessed their efforts, so that the little one has become tens of thousands, this Society having now about 20,000 adherents in Ontario, and hundreds of souls are yearly led to God by its instrumentality. During the past year revivals have been reported from almost every station, five new Churches have been built, the membership has increased 180, and the income of the Society is \$632.68, more than last year. It will be thus seen that we are not appealing to the people to sustain a lifeless organization. but a Missionary Society, that is most actively and successfully engaged in carrying out the designs of Christ concerning men. We have no need to enquire, is the Lord with us? for he has graciously visited and abundantly blessed us in our work. We have a debt of about \$9,000.00, which we are anxious to reduce. A little additional effort on the part of all our friends would easily meet the whole. We invite attention to the following condensed * reports from our Mission fields.

Belleville—During the year nine persons have given evidence of conversion to God: the Sabbath School has slightly improved. A commodious parsonage has been built at a cost of \$1500. The dullness of the times has considerably interfered with financial work. A revival of the Church is confidently expected.

HUNGERFORD.—This Mission has suffered considerably during the year from the general financial depression and removals, but the friends manifest a deep interest in the cause of God, and are hoping and praying for better days

CAMPBELLFORD.—This has been a year of trial, anxiety, and hard labor, Bro. Archer's family having suffered severe affliction. A new and commodious brick Parsonage has been erected at a cost (including Lot,&c.,) of about \$2,000, of which only \$700 remains as a debt. Three special meetings have been held, at which several persons have consecrated themselves to God; so that, after making up for losses from deaths, removals, &c., amounting to sixty-two, we report an increase of eighteen members. The congregations continue good, especially at Campbellford, the Church being too small to contain the people attending. We earnestly pray for more Spiritual Power and prosperity.

PORT HOPE.—The Lord of Hosts has been with us, granting us a measure of prosperity. Our congregations

ty. en with us, congregations have increased during the year at least 20 per cent., as have also the other means of grace. The Bible Class has largely increased. Financially we have done well; after meeting all our current working expenses, nearly \$200 have been raised toward the debt on the Parsonage. The means of grace have often been seasons of sweet delight, and gracious quickening. One of the results of our revival services was, an ingathering of thirty persons to the fellowship of the Church, and after making up for losses by deaths, removals, &c., we report an increase of twenty-two over last year. One great need is a more intelligent and practical piety.

PERRYTOWN—Has suffered somewhat from removals, we will nevertheless give thanks to our God for the success he has vouchsafed to us. We have paid off \$350 of the debt on the Perrytown Church. The Congregation at Providence is good. The building of a new Church is postponed. At Eden, the congregation has considerably improved, \$60 has been raised and expended on the Church property. A protracted meeting was held at this place which resulted in the quickening of the Church and adding about twenty persons to the membership. To God be all the praise.

Pickering.—While some of our best members have removed from the Circuit the Lord has been converting others to fill their places, so that we report an increase of ten members. During the year a great degree of peace and unity has prevailed among us. A Bible Class has been started at Duffins' Creek, which promises to be very successful. We have just taken up a new preaching appointment.

Oshawa.—The word of Life has been preached, the incorruptible seed of the kingdom scattered, and some precious fruit gathered: but the enemy has sown his tares, and both are growing together until the harvest. The special services were times of refreshing to some, a few professed faith in Christ, and are holding on their way Financially we still suffer from the general monetary depression, yet we have raised for Church purposes during the year. exclusive of Sabbath School work, the sum of \$1,336.00.

PRINCE ALBERT.—During the Year we have been engaged in sowing the incorruptible seed of Divine truth unsparingly, looking to Him who giveth sun and showers to quicken and fructify, so that a waving harvest, a hundredfold, may be the result. We have had evidence of the

power of God's truth to convince of sin, and that the Son of man hath still power upon earth to make the leprous clean. There have been admitted to our Societies forty-six persons; we have, however, suffered largely from removals, so that our increase is small. There is ample material here to make this at once a self-supporting circuit, but the difficulty is to get all to see their duty to their fellows, and their obligation to God. What we need is not simply a larger number of members, but that those we have, be more alive to duty, to privilege, and to God: not more talent, but that we have used for the advancement of righteousness, peace and joy, in the Holy Ghost; not more wealth, but that the wealth possessed shall be consecrated to Him, whose is the earth and the fullness thereof.

Uxbridge—Many of our meetings, especially in the village, have been seasons of refreshing, coming from the presence of the Lord. After a loss of thirty-one, by deaths, removals, and unfaithfulness, we report an increase of twelve members. Owing to the severe monetary depression, our finances are somewhat behind; but in view of all, we see reason to thank God and take courage.

TORONTO.—This year has been one of much anxiety and care, from two causes: The great financial depression, and the necessary removal of some of our friends. On the other hand, we have much cause for gratitude and hope. We have a small increase to our membership, notwithstanding eighteen removals, and we have a small surplus at the Quarter Board, notwithstanding a year of fearful financial depression, a result attributable to the successful working of the weekly offering system. Our membership is improved and improving, and the church is becoming more consolidated and reliable; but our Trust Estate requires to be yet further relieved, and our regular congregation to be augmented. The Sabbath School has been, and is energetically worked under our successful Superintendent, and a band of attached Teachers, while other bands of christian workers are trying to assist the pastor in Missionizing and Evangelizing around us, in this city.

Peterboro.—This has been a year of incessant toil; we have had the hearty co-operation of the officials and leading members of the church. In the Sabbath School, Prayer

God has frequently been graciously and powerfully present with us when assembled for worship. We have experienced, that it is good and pleasant for Brethren to dwell together in unity

ASHBURNHAM.—The Spiritual state of this Mission is somewhat improved; the Society is living in harmony. The congregation is small but regular in their attendance on the means of grace. On account of a variety of difficulties, this has been a very trying year, but still we are disposed to work and hope on.

FENELON.—After another year's toil, we are thankful to report that our congregations are generally good. A few persons have been made new creatures in Christ Jesus, and are rejoicing in the pardon of their sins; some improvement has been made on the church properties. The church at the Falls has been painted and paid for, the debt on the Ebenezer Church has been paid off. The Sabbath Schools are doing well never better than they are now. We will rejoice and give thanks to the Lord.

SUTTON.—The congregations continue good, some souls have been quickened. The debt on three churches has been reduced.

Manvers & Cartwright.—During the past year we have been very busily engaged. Janetville Parsonage was completed last summer at a cost of about \$1200, \$500 of which has been paid, leaving a debt of \$700. Two new brick churches have been built at Fleetwood, and Franklin, at a cost of about \$1600 each, the outlay all being provided for. The Debt on the Williamsburg church has been reduced to \$100. Spiritually there has been considerable progress, so that after making up for twenty-six removals we have an increase of thirty members.

LINDSAY.—has suffered much from removals during the year. •The special services held in the winter proved to be seasons of refreshing to the church, and adding considerably to our members. Financially the friends have done well, the Missionary and Quarterly receipts being \$155.21, in advance of last year. \$275 have been paid on the church

debt. The congregations have improved, and the Sabbath School prospers, being conducted by a devoted staff of Teachers. During the year several of the Scholars have been hopefully converted.

Wiarton.—During the year we have had peace within our borders, and prosperity within our palaces. Our congregations have been good, class and prayer meetings moderately well attended. A church has been built at Colpoy's Bay, at a cost of \$500, \$450 of which has been provided for. A church is in course of erection at Oxenden. The Sabbath School department of our work is very encouraging. Bro. Woodman has nobly assisted the Pastor. We report an increase of twenty members. We thank God and take courage.

Palmerston.—We are enabled to raise our Ebenezer and exclaim with Samuel, "Hitherto the Lord has helped us." Numerically we stand about the same as last year. Financially we are improving, our Missionary receipts are better than formerly. We expect that during the summer a church

will be built in Harriston

CLINTON.—The Parsonage has been moved to the corner of William and Rattenbury streets, a stone foundation and cellar built, and the expenses provided for. We have a new appointment at Mount Hope, congregation about 70, an eligible lot for a church (deeded to the Connexion) has been presented. A brick church (56 × 38), with basement and end gallery, is in course of erection in Clinton. Monetary depression severely felt, yet by diligent effort, receipts are equal to expenditure. Special Meetings were held at Clinton and Summerhill, with good results Sabbath School interest is increasing, congregations larger and a good spirit of hearing prevails.

DEREHAM.—During the year we have toiled hard, and have realized some success. Special services were held at Bethel, lukewarm professors were blessedly quickened, backsliders were reclaimed, and many sinners professed to be saved through believing in Jesus.

INGERSOLL.—The past year has been one of hard labor and much anxiety of mind, but we feel thankful to the great head of the church, that we have not labored in vain. The congregations both at Ingersoll and Putnamville have im

St. Thomas.—The organization of another society at Talbotville, has considerably augmented our members and influence, and we hope that a sphere of usefu ness and spiritual life has thus been opened that will prove a blessing to many in the present and future. Our congregations are appreciative in attention, and increasingly good in attendance. During many weeks of special effort, the Master's presence and saving power were graciously realized; a number were savingly converted who have united with the church, and the entire membership were quickened. Our regular and social means of grace, are at present, all seasons of refreshing, and are heartily participated in by a good attendance. In material things we also report prosperity; early during the year our new Brick Church at Talbotville was completed, and dedicated. The entire cost, together with that of a commodious driving shed, were covered by cash and subscriptions. The St. Thomas Church has undergone some alterations and renovations during the year. The re-opening services were eminently successful, and the entire expenses provided for. Our position improved in every way, gives us greater prestige, than ever possessed before.

LAMBETH.—Our congregations at Lambeth and Deleware are good and steadily increasing. At Westminster the congregation is small, yet our cause is standing on a firmer footing than at any former period, our friends here are of one heart and mind. We have not been visited with any special revivals yet, we have had clear evidences of God's presence and blessing, and a few souls have been saved. Numbers of those who were admitted on trial last year have had their names left off the class book. Financially we have done well, both the Missionary and Quarterly receipts are in advance of last year. The membership are

living together in peace and unity.

WINDSOR.—Our congregations continue good, completely filling the church Sabbath evenings, and the Sabbath-school is in good working order. The church has been painted with three coats of paint, and the walls and ceiling has been

beautiful, which adds greatly to its appearance. We trust the foundation for a future prosperity is laid broad and deep.

May the good Lord baptize us all.

Colchester, reports that, during the year believers have been quickened and strengthened, and quite a number, mostly from the Sabbath-school, have given their hearts to God, joined our churches, and are endeavoring to live for Christ. At Gesto twenty-five persons have been received in the society. The society is in a healthy condition. A new driving shed has been erected at a cost of \$70, and \$25 have been raised towards the Organ Fund. At Sandwich East the congregation is good, and a few have joined the Church. At the North the congregation has considerably improved, the society is increasing and hopeful We have also taken up a week evening appointment in the township of Anderson.

Hamilton.—Our success has not been such as we fondly hoped for, yet we have not labored in vain nor spent our strength for naught. Our protracted meetings was measurably successful. The members were quickened into newness of life, several won for Christ, and the congregation considerably increased. Financially it has been a hard year with us, on account of many of our people being out of employment during a portion of the year. The Sabbath

school is in a promising condition.

SUMMERSIDE, P.E.I.—The past year has been one of much depression. Our prosperity of former years, which kept pace with the rapid advancement of the town, has participated largely in the general depression, which seems to pervade everything. Several of our people have had to go to other places to seek employment, thus reducing our congregations. Although we are thus passing through a very trying period in our history, yet we have cause to rejoice; the power of God has been realized in our midst, some souls have been converted. Our Sunday-school is advancing in numbers and interest, and in it we have faithful teachers doing good work for the Master.

WHEATLEY RIVER P. E. I.—Our labors have not been in vain during the year. Our services have been well attended, we have realized much of the Divine power cheering and reviving us in our work. The Sabbath schools have somewhat improved. Financially the friends have done

STATISTICS.

The following statistical table shows that the society employs 38 Ministers, who are assisted by 70 Local Preachers. and who preach in 83 churches, and 29 other places; 358 persons are on trial for membership making the total number of members 2852; Sunday school teachers 503; scholars 3565; showing an increase of 6 churches, 6 Local Preachers, 180 members, 49 Sunday school teachers, and 141 scholars.
