

## BILL.

An Act to authorize the City of Kingston to negotiate a Locu of Seventy-five Thousand Pounds to consolidate the City Debt, and for other purposes.

HEREAS the City of Kingston have petitioned to be au-Preamble. thorized by law to borrow on the debentures of the said City, a sum not exceeding seventy-five thousand pounds, for 5 certain purposes and under certain restrictions in the said petition set forth, and it is expedient that the prayer of their said petition should be granted; Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Pro-10 vice of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, "An Act " to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for

Britain or elsewhere, as the said Common Council shall deem expedient or necessary.
