**B I L L .**

**An Act to amend the Act therein mentioned for the protection of Indians in Upper Canada, by repealing the third Section thereof.**

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act hereinafter mentioned by repealing the third Section thereof; Be it therefore enacted, &c., Preamble.

5 That the third Section of the Act passed in the Session held in the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act for the protection of the Indians in Upper Canada from imposition, and the property occupied by them from trespass or injury,*" shall be, and the said Section is hereby repealed. Sect. 3 of 13 and 14 Vic. cap. 74 repealed.

10 II. And be it enacted, That the time elapsed between the coming into force of the Act hereinbefore cited and the coming into force of this Act, shall not be reckoned in computing the time within which an action must be brought on any Bond, Bill, Note, Promise or other Contract, or for the recovery of any debt referred to in the said Section of the said Act, in order to prevent its being  
15 barred by the Statute of Limitations. A certain period not to be reckoned as regards the Statute of Limitations.
