BUSY GALT; MILLION. Two Important Towns Which Deserved Rank High.

Visit to the Manchester of the Dominion—The World Visits the Busy Manufactories of Both These Centres of Business—Their Public Institutions, Churches and Emporiums of Trade—Interesting Particulars.

GALT IS A TOWN AROUND which cluster many interesting local associations and in the turbulent times of the rebellion it took its share in making Canadian history. As everybody knows it was named after John Galt, the father of Alexander Galt, who afterwards became the Finance Minister, and on whom the order of Knighthood was conferred some years ago.

It is situated in the Township of North Dumfries, in the County of Waterloo, and is distant from Berlin, the county seat, 12 miles. Galt is on the main line of the Credit Valley Railway and is a station of the Wellington, Grey and Bruce Division of the Grand River, which is the main artery of the Galt branch of the G. R. Its location in the valley of the Grand River, with the rising ground on either side, is very picturesque, and the beautiful residences which are the height of both sides of the river are the admiration of the visitor.

Water-works, next door to Fraser's, are an excellent feature of the town. It is a large and modern plant, and is supplied with water from the Grand River, which is the main artery of the Galt branch of the G. R. Its location in the valley of the Grand River, with the rising ground on either side, is very picturesque, and the beautiful residences which are the height of both sides of the river are the admiration of the visitor.

The churches are mostly all imposing and costly edifices of splendid architectural design. The Central Presbyterian Church is a magnificent stone building, with spire rising 135 feet above the ground, and cost \$30,000. Rev. Mr. Dickson is the pastor.
