IT IS SIMPLY THE JOCKEY CLUB.

Incorporation Articles of Uncle Sam's New Organization Signed—A strong list of signatories.

New York, Feb. 9.—The new jockey club has at last been organized and named. It will be known simply as the Jockey Club.

Articles of incorporation were drawn up yesterday afternoon and forwarded to the Secretary of State at Albany, and within a few days the new club will be a legally incorporated body.

Among those who signed the articles of incorporation yesterday were William C. Whitney, Col. O. H. Payne, F. K. Sturges, Perry Belmont, Col. W. P. Thompson, J. B. Haggin, John Hunter, J. Cassatt, James Galvin and Dr. G. L. Knapp.

The following were named as directors of the Jockey Club for 1894: Messrs. August Belmont, J. R. Keese, John Hunter, Col. W. P. Thompson, J. O. Donner, F. K. Sturges and Dr. G. L. Knapp.

The policy adopted by the English jockey club having a superior standard of ability, jealousy or ill-will being in the way.

The club will publish a studbook or book for registry of horses in the United States and Canada, to promote the best exhibition of such horses generally for the purpose of improving the breed of horses.

Johanne Goldast Kills His Owner. Mr. E. K. Weaver, a Buffalo lawyer, the principal owner, Johanne Goldast, at Buffalo, was killed in a runaway accident in Buffalo this week. It appears that Mr. Weaver and Miss Looney, the latter of Buffalo, were out for a ride at Buffalo, when Goldast, who was frightened and turned around suddenly, throwing the occupants to the center of the road. The lady fell in the snow and was not injured, but Mr. Weaver clung to the lines and was dashed against a tree, the blow rendering him unconscious and from which he never recovered. He was taken to the hospital and died on Feb. 10. It was the property for some time of Mr. Thomas Tor, who sold him to Weaver, as follows: As it is generally understood, Goldast was always easily frightened and very unmanageable when thoroughly scared.

The \$2500 Silver Queen Arrives. New York, Feb. 9.—The steamer Queen, which arrived at Quarantine just before sunset tonight, has on board the famous mare, Silver Queen, purchased by Mr. E. D. Morgan for \$2500.

HANLAN AND GAUDAUR. The Great Scullers May Row Double with Sullivan and Harding.

Sullivan, the Australian sculler, now located in London, and Wag Harding, who defeated Huber this week, have challenged J. Hanlan and Gaudaur to row a double scull on the Thames for the coming summer.

The Canadian champion will accept, most likely and, strange as it may seem, will have Ned Hanlan in the double scull.

John Hanlan has been made, and it is just possible that Duran will partner the British sculler.

Sullivan is very anxious to get on a match with Hanlan in the single, and has made the above proposition as an extra inducement to get the Orillon race on the water.

Richard K. Fox telegraphed to Gaudaur yesterday that the Englishman wanted a sculler for \$25,000, but he thinks they will row for less.

Stanbury should have taken McLean, a quondam partner in a double scull, and with Gaudaur, who has raised in the past a name from Vancouver about a prospective partner for the kangaroo waterman and canoeist.

Raise Cheese, Says McCarthy. For some reason or other the McCarthy movement makes no perceptible headway. It has been already proved to the satisfaction of those who have watched the movement that a new party cannot be formed on a platform whose planks are personal jealousy, religious animosity and amateur politics.

There is nothing more remarkable than the unwillingness of the public to assure the absolute safety of money letters by registering them, and yet in most cases they prefer taking chances throughout Toronto where letters can be registered, but the trouble seems to be distasteful, or is it the extra payment of five cents that is in the way of this obvious precaution being taken.

Manufacturers' Life Insurance Company. The seventh annual report of the Manufacturers' Life Insurance Company, which appears upon another page, shows the progress and progressive home company to be in a solid financial condition. Union Loan and Savings Company. The stockholders of the Union Loan and Savings Co. held their 20th annual meeting on Wednesday last. The report was an excellent one, the total assets of the company amounting to \$2,700,707.52, of which \$2,568,276.01 is invested in mortgages in the Province of Ontario.

FINANCE AND TRADE.

Margins on what were called frosts yesterday. The Chicago market was in a soupy condition, and the May option sold down to 50c, a decline of 2c for the day, and the lowest price on record. The tickers appeared extremely anxious. The reports are that outsiders unloaded freely, and many deals were closed on stop-orders.

The bondholders of the Duluth and Manitoba Railway, running from Winnipeg Junction, on the Northern Pacific, to Winnipeg, met a few days ago. This road is in one of the hands of a receiver. A resolution was passed appointing a committee of six to represent the interests of the bondholders in the receivership proceedings.

The sugar clause of the Wilson tariff bill meets with bitter opposition from the friends of the Southern sugar interests. Delegates from the Louisiana sugar, rice, and other exchanges and business associations, at a meeting in New Orleans, adopted resolutions calling upon the Senate to reverse the action of the House on sugar.

Two Sisters Meet After Being Separated Half a Century. In September last an advertisement appeared in The Toronto Globe asking the whereabouts of Catharine and Bridget Clark, formerly in the neighborhood of Calabona, but who had removed from there to the neighborhood of St. Samuel in 1843. THE END OF THE KEARSARGE

A TERRIBLE NIGHT'S EXPERIENCE ON THE OLD SHIP.

Waves Pounded Her Universally All Night, and the Crew Experienced Death Moments.

New York, Feb. 9.—A special to the Herald from Colon says: The Kearsarge was wrecked on Underwood's reef last Friday evening, Feb. 2. The Kearsarge was under full sail and steam at the time, and was going about 10 knots when she struck. A heavy sea was running and as the character of the waves in these waters was well-known to the Kearsarge's officers, it was evident that they were in for a rough time.

CROFTON ON TRIAL

The Man Who Forged Note on the Bank of Toronto.

Algeron Francis Blake Crofton last October presented at the First National Bank, Chicago, for payment a draft for \$7000, drawn on the Bank of Montreal, Man., by the Winnipeg Bank paid to the bank in the city bank, who paid it to Crofton. The draft subsequently proved to be a forgery. In November Crofton was arrested in El Paso, Texas, and brought to Chicago. He had spent a large amount of the money.

Yesterday in court his attorney said that he would enter a plea of guilty if he could be sent to the Reformatory. Crofton is not yet 21 years old, but soon will be. The State objected to the plea, as that would practically be a punishment, for the moment Crofton became 21 years old he could demand and obtain his liberty. Crofton's attorney insisted that under a plea of guilty it was obligatory upon the court to sentence the prisoner to the Reformatory. The case was continued.

Crofton was married a few months ago at Peterboro, where he was formerly employed.
