CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

The lumber trade of the past week has not been particularly active, when consideration is given to the fine building weather. In some quarters disappointment with the volume of business is expressed, while on the other hand some manufacturers and dealers state that they are experiencing a brisk demand for lumber for immediate shipment. Several blocks of pine in the Georgian Bay district have recently changed hands for shipment to the east principally. Most of the mills on the Georgian bay are in operation, some of them with day and night crews, so that within a few weeks there will be considerable of the new cut ready for the market. The water in the streams is favorable for driving operations, and most of the logs are likely to reach the mills. While pine prices are being held firmly, this is not equally true of hardwoods. A tendency is shown by a few manufacturers to cut prices, in the hope of disposing of their old stock. This, however, is not the general disposition, as there doubtless exists a strong sentiment against any reduction from the prices which have been established for some time past. It is believed that the small number who are compelled to realize will not have any appreciable effect on the market. Lath continues to gain in strength. As high as \$2.60 for No. 1 at the mill is occasionally asked, although the average price is about ten cents below this figure. Retail yards in Toronto are asking \$3.75.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

Chartering of vessels to carry lumber has been more active during the past week, and it is probable that considerable shipments will be made this year to South America and the West Indies. France will also take a larger quantity than last year, as between 10,000,000 and 15,000,000 feet has already been sold to that market. Shippers to Great Britain are still holding back in the hope that prices will improve. Although prices are not likely to be as high as last year, shippers will receive an advantage on account of lower freight rates. New Brunswick cedar shingles are slightly easier, from the fact that most mills have resumed operations. Prices are in the neighborhood of \$2.95 for extras, \$2.25 for clears, and \$2.25 for second clears.

UNITED STATES.

Some incidents looking towards higher price for lumber in the United States have taken place within the last week. In Chicago sales of white pine piece stuff are reported at from \$13 to \$13.50 for short, while at Ashland common inch pine is

held at \$15. There is a scarcity of certain grades at most of the mills on Lake Superior, and at a meeting of the price list committee of the association representing that district, to be held this week, it is expected that an advance of 50 cents will be made on these grades. This advance is not intended to represent a general marking up of prices, as the market is almost certain to be affected by the new cut which will be ready for the market in about one month. Then it would be strange if prices did not become a little easier. The demand for sash and doors continues, and on account of the scarcity of shop lumber, substitutes for white pine are being used as far as possible. Eastern spruce is very firm, as is also hemlock. At Menominee the price is \$8.25 on the dock for short hemlock, and \$9.25 to \$9.50 for long. A slight improvement in hardwoods is reported. Maple has been selling freely at lower prices, although it is understood that in Buffalo an effort is being made to prevent the cutting of prices. Eastern yards are showing a disposition to stock up.

Lath and shingles are in short supply and below the requirements. For New Brunswick cedar shingles of first quality, \$2.95 to \$3 is asked in Boston. Buffalo dealers have no supply of white pine shingles, and are giving most of their attention to red cedars.

GREAT BRITAIN.

As yet there have been few signs that the British market is recovering from its lethargy. Perhaps the only relief is found in the increased consumption in London, where stocks are heavy and badly in need of being reduced to a lower level. Importers are prepared to buy at a speculative price, but show little willingness to meet the prices asked by shippers. There seems to be a disposition on the part of manufacturers in exporting countries to curtail the production, a movement in this direction being now under way in Sweden. Pine and spruce deals are selling from stock quite freely, but some reaction in the price of the latter is reported. At a recent auction sale in London 3x11 third quality spruce averaged £8 2s 6d per standard, and 3x9 third quality £9. Square timber has also sold lower. Ashlogs have been received in large quantities from the United States, and are not meeting with ready sale. A parcel of Quebec oak

logs was sold at a recent sale at 15 1/2d per cubic foot, birch planks at 1s 3d, oak planks at 1 3/4d to 2 1/4d, and quartered oak boards at an average of 2 1/4d per foot.

FIRES.

Owen's saw and planing mills at Ridgetown, Ont., were destroyed by fire last week, at a loss of \$4,000.

The saw mill of the Trout Creek Lumber Co., at Nipissing, Ont., was burned last Sunday. The loss is \$6,000 with no insurance.

CORRESPONDENCE SOLICITED

THE OTTAWA VALLEY.

(Correspondence of the CANADA LUMBERMAN.)

The chief topic in local lumber circles is the announcement by Mr. J. R. Booth of his intention to move his sawmill from Ottawa. Since the fire a year ago, there has been a strong agitation to prohibit, or at least restrict, lumber piling in the residential sections. It was contended that the long avenues of lumber fed the flame and indirectly caused the destruction of other valuable property. No action was taken in the matter further than the amendment of the fire by-law, which requires that the lumber shall be piled at a safe distance from residences and other structures. This does not satisfy the extremists, who are still clamoring for the removal of the piles. There is also a scheme under way having for its object the imposition of a tax on lumber piled within the city limits.

The avoidance of these threatened restrictions furnishes one reason for Mr. Booth's desire to locate elsewhere. He stated that a site would be chosen on the Ottawa below the city, where advantage can be taken of the river for the transportation of logs and lumber.

Many believe, however, that Mr. Booth will reconsider his proposal, and continue his lumber business here. The removal of it would mean a serious blow to both Hull and Ottawa.

As soon as the water in the Ottawa recedes sufficiently, blasting operations will be commenced on the site of the new mill at the Chaudiere, to be erected by the Hull and Ottawa Pulp, Power and Paper Company. The ruins of the Hull Lumber Company's mill have all been cleared away, ready for the blasting. The new company has just acquired possession of a portion of the Table Rock from the Quebec Government, situated alongside the property secured from the Hull Lumber Company. These, along with the adjoining area secured from Mr. Alexander Fraser, gives the new company control of the Table Rock and adjoining water power. Mr. Wm. Kennedy, of Montreal, consulting engineer of the company, is now preparing plans for the new building. A power house will also be erected for the generation and distribution of power for manufacturing purposes.

All the mills in and about Ottawa are now running full time. The Hull Lumber Company is operating Mason's mill at Hintonburg and will also operate Ritchie Brothers' mill at Aylmer as soon as the

new machinery of larger capacity is installed. Mr. J. R. Booth's, Gilmour & Hughson's and W. C. Edward's mills are all in full swing. There should be no scarcity of logs this season, as the drives are all being well handled on account of the high water. During the past week the logs have been coming down the Gatineau in large numbers. There are at present over 70,000 at the boom. Several large rafts of logs have also been handled on Lake Deschenes for local mill owners. These logs came from the tributaries of the Upper Ottawa.

There is no change in prices in the Ottawa lumber market, which holds firm. No break is looked for; indeed, a further advance is conceded, as several lines are sold out. Although the present mill operations will relieve the stringency, a heavy demand will sustain prices.

Navigation is now open on the Ottawa river and Rideau canal, and lumber shippers have taken early advantage of the fact. Several barges belonging to the Ottawa Transportation Company's fleet have been loaded at the Chaudiere docks for American points. Shipments by rail are also brisk. A new spur line has been laid, connecting with the Export Lumber Co.'s yards and those of Mr. J. R. Booth.

The E. B. Eddy Company is carrying out extensive plans for the improvement of its fire protection. A second large water tower has been erected. The first was built near the match factory and paper mills in the west end of Hull. The second one is being erected in the east end, near the sulphite mill. These towers have a capacity of several thousand gallons of water, thus furnishing increased pressure for the water mains. The buildings have also been supplied with automatic sprinklers. Work on the new paper mills is being rushed ahead and building operations on the Eddy Co.'s premises promise to be even brisker than they were last year.

TIMBER LIMIT PURCHASE.

It is reported that the Ross timber limits and mica mines in the province of Quebec have been purchased by McLaren & Co., of Buckingham and Ottawa. The limits are extensive and the consideration is said to have been in the neighborhood of \$500,000.

Prouty & Miller have a large drive of logs in Cherry river, Que., en route to their mill.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

Logan & Sutherland, of Musquodoboit Harbor, N. S., expect to cut 11,000,000 feet of lumber this year.

Montgomery Bros. & Co., of Buffalo, have just received a cargo of mill culls from Deseronto, Ont., purchased through Rathbun & Company, of Oswego.

John Hanbury, of Brandon, Man., has a drive of 125,000 logs on its way from the Riding Mountains to his mill. He expects to cut 8,000,000 feet this year.

Further advances have been made in the price of spruce logs. T. H. Lawler, of Bangor, N.S., has 4,000,000 feet for sale for which he is asking \$16.50 per thousand. He is reported to have refused an offer of \$15.75.
