THE OPPORTUNITIES

International Trade Minister, John C. Crosbie, today announced a series of conferences designed to help Canadian business explore the new trade opportunities flowing from the Canada-U.S. Free Trade Agreement.

The Minister launched a Canada-wide conference series that will begin on June 21, in Saskatoon, and end on July 7, in Saint-John, New Brunswick. The conference series, part of the communication initiatives that the Minister had recently made public, will provide a detailed program tailored to the needs of experienced exporters as well as those of new exporters who wish to participate in Canada's expanded trade opportunities.

"We want to assist Canadian business people to prepare for the new opportunities in the U.S. market that will flow from the Free Trade Agreement", said Mr. Crosbie. "Canada will gain increased and more secure access to the largest market in the world, the United States, and we want to ensure that Canadian businesses are well prepared", added Mr. Crosbie.

Each conference will provide specific information on sectoral opportunities identified in recent research as well as on government services to assist exporters. Business people will have access to trade commissioners from Canada's missions in the United States during geographic and sector workshops which will review successful marketing methods south of the border and explore the new opportunities created by the Free Trade Agreement. Canadian Government officials from the Department of External Affairs and the Department of Regional Industrial Expansion and private industry speakers will also provide concrete advice on how to succeed in the developing new trade environment. Each conference will have a special workshop devoted specifically to the interests of companies who have never before exported.

These conferences will be open to the media.
