



On arriving at the Ground, there shall be sung:

Then shall be sung or said the Psalm following:

PSALM LXXXIV.

- O HOW amiable are thy dwellings: thou Lord of hosts.
- 2. My soul hath a desire and longing to enter into the courts of the Lord: my heart and my flesh rejoice in the living God.
- 3. Yea, the sparrow hath found her an house, and the swallow a nest where she may lay her young: even Thy altars, oh Lord of hosts, my King and my God.
- 4. Blessed are they that dwell in Thy house: they will be a ways praising Thee.
- 5. Blessed is the man whose strength is in Thee: in whose heart are Thy ways;
- 6. Who going through the vale of misery use it for a well: and the pools are filled with water.
- 7. They will go from strength to strength: and unto the God of Gods appeareth every one of them in Zion.

- 8. Oh, Lord God of hosts, hear my prayer: hearken, oh God of Jacob.
- 9. Behold, oh God our defender: and look upon the face of Thine annointed.
- 10. For one day in Thy courts: is better than a thousand.
- 11. I had rather be a door-keeper in the house of my God: than dwell in the tents of ungodliness.
- 12. For the Lord God is a light a d a defence: the Lord will give grace and worship, and no good thing shall he withhold from them that live a godly life.
- 13. Oh Lord God of hosts: blessed is the man that putteth his trust in Thee.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy'Ghost.

As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Saying:

THIS STONE IS LAID IN FAITH AND HOPE, TO THE HONOR AND GLORY OF GOD, THROUGH JESUS CHRIST OUR LORD Amen.

Priest—The Glorious Majesty of the Lord our God be upon us: prosper Thou the work of our hands upon us: oh prosper Thou our handy work.

Lord have mercy upon us.

Our Father which art in Heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive them that trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory, for ever and ever, Amen.

And to one hope she presses
With every grace endued.

Though with a scornful wonder
Men see her sore opprest,
By schisms rent asunder,
By heresies distrest,
Yet saints their watch are keeping,
Their cry goes up, "How long?"
And soon the night of weeping
Shall be the morn of song.

Mid toil and tribulation,
And tumult of her war,
She waits the consummation
Of peace for evermore;
Till with the vision glorious
Her longing eyes are blest,
