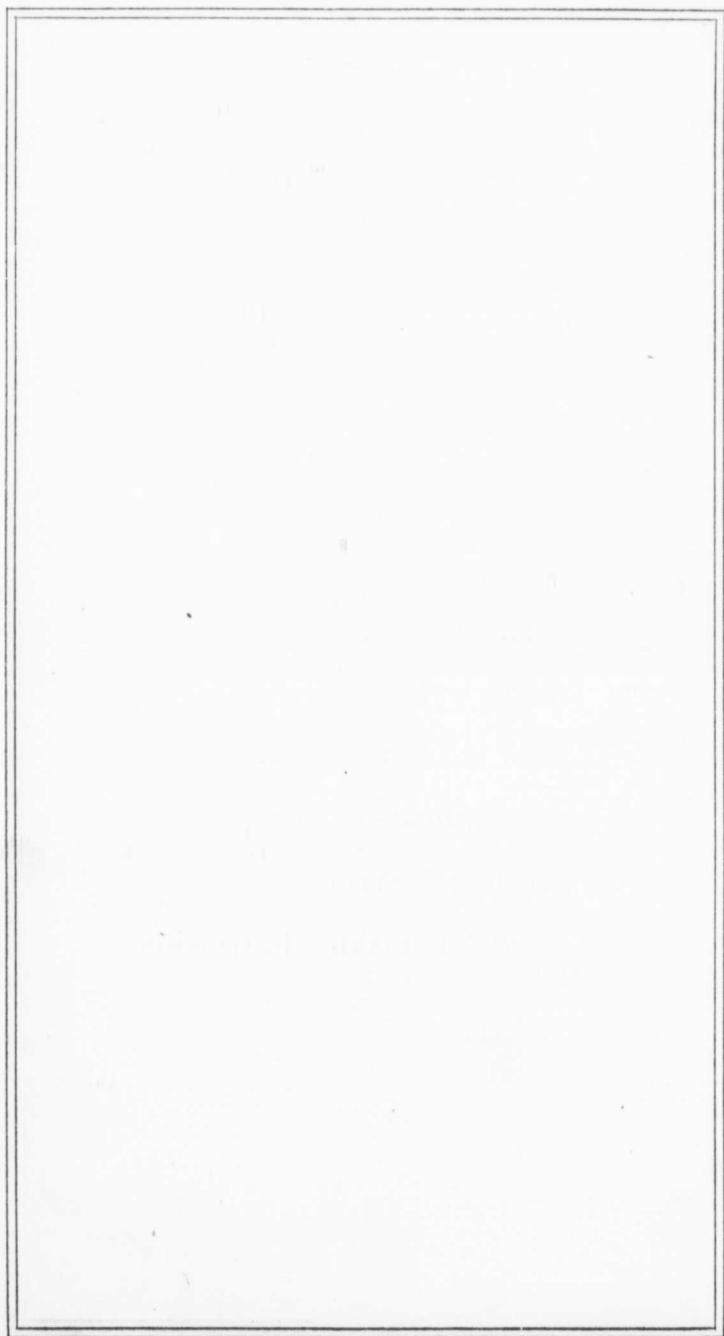

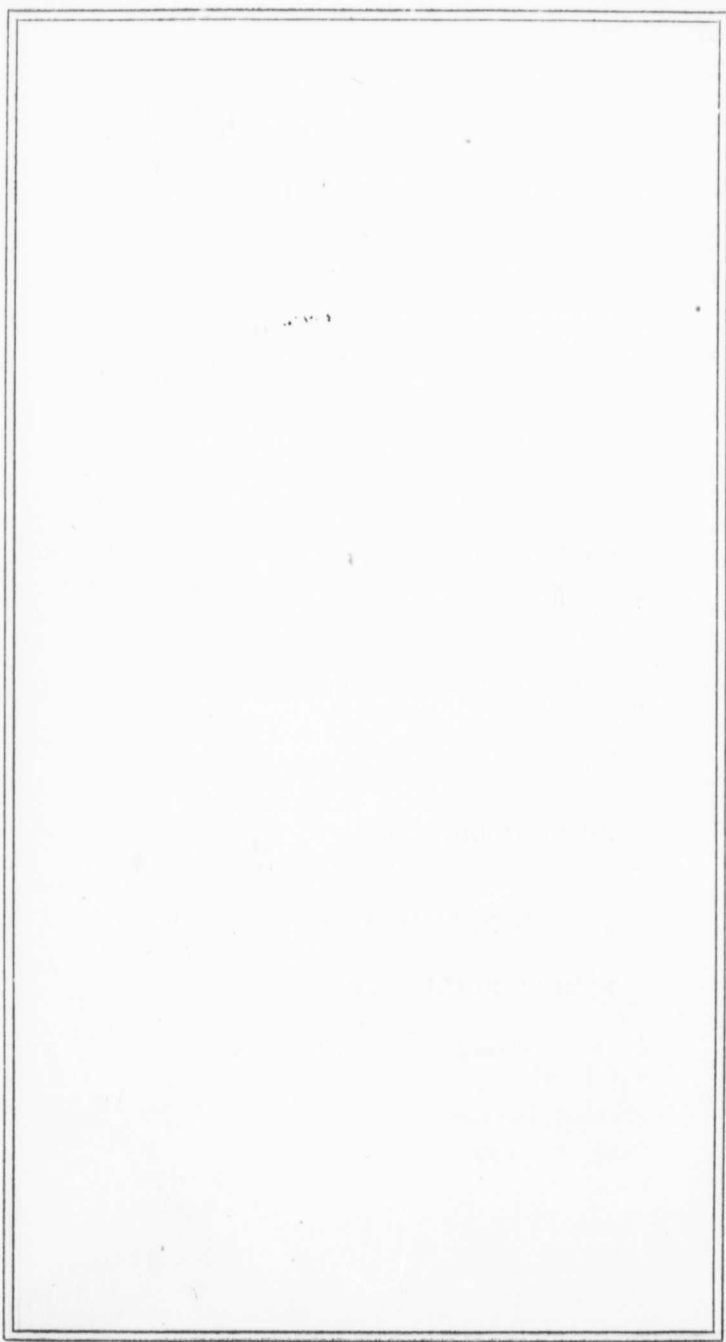

ST. STEPHEN ACADEMY.

IN their first Catalogue, the Trustees will briefly state what they have done, and to what they aspire.

They have erected a building, a superiority to which in tastefulness and conveniences, is claimed for no school edifice in this Province or the adjacent State.

By the liberality of the Provincial Legislature, they have been enabled to procure Apparatus to the value of £150, for the illustration of Natural Philosophy; and they design to make adequate provision for other branches of Natural Science, as the wants of the school shall demand.

The past year they have provided Teachers to an extent equal to the constant employment of four persons during the usual school hours. They will always seek the services of Instructors, well-qualified, efficient, and deserving of general favor.

They have deemed it advisable that unusual attention should be given to young pupils and the common branches of knowledge; but still it is their design to furnish facilities for an extended course of study, so far as classes become prepared to pursue it. The following is the proposed
