## SPECIAL APPEAL.

---

*To the Members of the Congregation of St. James's Cathedral:*

The Rector and Churchwardens had hoped to make a personal canvass of the Congregation, but have found the process altogether too slow to meet the urgency of the occasion. They therefore hope that Members of the Congregation will accept this circular in lieu of a personal call, on the subject it relates to.

The financial statement submitted this year shows the position of the Church in regard to the completion of the improvements. Of the work yet proposed to be done and not yet provided for (to cost some \$18,000) it will be observed that items representing fully \$9,000 are all of an absolutely necessary character, and should be executed at once, to put the Church in a becoming condition.

To raise this amount we ask each of the remaining members of the congregation who can possibly do so (less than 100 in number upon the list), to contribute to the utmost extent possible, by cheques payable in July, October, and January next. This necessary sum provided, we can leave the additional features, of a less necessary though highly desirable character, to be provided by members able and willing to do so.

The present appeal is urgent, and a reply is requested before the 30th inst., when the Finance Committee meet to decide finally on the contracts for the coming summer. If all contracts can be settled at this date, the work can be completed between the 1st July and the 1st September. Contracts, however, cannot be let until the funds are provided.

If the congregation will contrast the financial position of the Church, as shewn by the statement of this year, referring to the debt and income, with its condition and prospects a few years past, they must recognise that prolonged and arduous labour has been necessary to accomplish the results shewn. The only thanks we hope to receive is a prompt and generous response to this present appeal.
