The attention of Missionaries is requested to the following Resolution of the Committee, passed in August, 1872 :—That the Secretary shall, previously to each Quarterly Meeting, prepare a tabular view of the numerical and financial state of the missions ; also a synoptical statement of the business to be done ; and in order to do this, missions shall hold their quarterly meetings sufficiently early to enable them to have their reports to the Mission Office not less than one week previous to the meeting of the Committee ; and in case any of the Missionaries shall fail in doing so, their reports shall not be read, nor their grants sent, until the succeeding meeting. The Committee earnestly hope that all the brethren will assist in enabling the Secretary to carry out the above arrangement, so that they may have time to discuss what really pertains to the good of the mission work.

The Quarterly Meeting of these Committees shall be held in Toronto, on Thursday, the 3rd of August, and Thursday, the 4th of November, 1875 ; Thursday, the 3rd of February, and Thursday, the 4th of May, 1876. Each Meeting to commence at 9 o'clock, a.m.

REPORT.

ADDRESS OF THE GENERAL MISSIONARY COMMITTEE.

To the Ministers, Collectors and Friends of the Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada:

DEAR CHRISTIAN BRETHREN AND FRIENDS:—Since we last addressed you, one more year is numbered with the past; and again it is our duty and privilege to speak to you on the cause in which we all have so deep an interest. None of us need offer any apology for the interest we feel in the cause of God; it has done much for us personally, for our families, for our country, and the nations which have accepted the teachings of the Gospel of Christ. It has done, and will do infinitely more than we can ever estimate the value of. In place of apology for our love to God's cause, we would rather say, in nothing will we glory save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ. God's gracious purpose is, by the Gospel to save men—to save the world; to save souls by the preaching of the Gospel, is the object contemplated by your Committee, and nothing can be more natural than at the end of the year to ask the question, what success has resulted from the united efforts of God's workers. As those who are interested in the work of God generally, we cannot but look beyond the portion of the great vineyard which we cultivate, to see how other toilers in the field prosper; and it must be gratifying to all who love our Lord Jesus Christ, to know that during the past year some of the most glorious victories ever witnessed, have been won for Christ—thousands, and tens of thousands of souls have been saved. The wonderful work of grace which has taken place in Great Britain and Ireland, particularly in London, England, under the labors of Moody and Sankey, is a work so glorious, and so blessed in its results, as to call forth the gratitude of the universal Church of Christ. It is to be hoped that its influence will go on widening its circles, and indirectly reach thousands who have not been reached by it directly.

We exceedingly rejoice that while other branches of the Church have been prospering, God has crowned the labors of the Primitive Methodist Church with great success. The English Conference reports an increase of over 5,000 members; and in every respect the numerical report is equally satisfactory, especially in the Sabbath School department, the increase in scholars being, as usual, over 10,000. By Sabbath school work the connexion has a wide spread influence. It is not easy

to go to any place in the colonies of Great Britain, and not find people who have received the rudiments of Christian doctrine, and their first religious impressions in our Sabbath schools; and, also, in many other countries of the world. Thus seed is sown which bears fruit in far off lands; and is found many days afterwards. The English conference is earnestly and successfully prosecuting the Home and Foreign Mission work. The Home Mission work they are pushing with a vigor and earnestness which is worthy of, and which secures success. The heathen Mission work, they find, as most, if not all other Missionary societies have found it, that enlightening and saving the heathen is slow work for a time. But the Church's history shows that though it may be for a time slow work, it is only a work of time, and that ultimate and great success is certain. Of this they have already clear indications in Fernando Po. Some of the poor heathen have been converted—are now members of the Church, and their simple but clear experience and changed lives, gives evidence that the work is real. And how glorious the change! and what a subject for joyous thanksgiving to God! The Mission has already cost much, and is likely to be a very expensive one for a long time to come; but what is money compared with the salvation of souls! Think of men living in ignorance of themselves, their spiritual state, and their responsibilities and future destiny—ignorant of God, their relationship and obligation to Him—of Christ, and the way of salvation through Him; and then think of the change effected by the Gospel, and, shall we not conclude that it is worth unspeakably more than it costs in money and labor.

In this country, God has blessed us largely during the past year. Nearly all our stations have been favoured with outpourings of the Holy Spirit. Revivals of religion have taken place; and many souls have been saved. After filling up the many vacancies occasioned by deaths, removals and other causes, the Mission stations report an increase of 300 members; and 313 Sabbath School children, and in every other department progress has been made. We are sure this will be encouraging to you, as it is to your Committee.

In our last report, reference was made to three new Missions taken up—we regret that the one at Manitoba did not succeed as well as was expected, at least, in gathering people into the church. But peculiar difficulties were to be contended with, and after serious deliberations the Conference decided that at present the Missionary should be withdrawn, hoping that at some future time we shall be able to take it up again, and prosecute the work with vigor and success. At St. Catharines, God graciously opened the way of his servant; souls have been saved, a society raised, steps are being taken to build a new church, and the prospects for success are very cheering. At Montreal, great difficulties have been met with. It is clear, that to go into a large city, and build up a cause, is a work which requires great self-denial, constant, earnest, zealous labor; but sooner or later such efforts are sure to meet with success—so it has been in this great city—God has been glorified in

the salvation of souls. The prospect was not very encouraging at first, but the present is much brighter than the past, and the prospect for the future, looks brighter than the present. What is needed is a church or two, to give character to the cause, and also to give it the appearance of permanence and stability, and thus secure the confidence of those who are brought within the influence of the blessed truth, as it is in Jesus. The Mission will be for a time, a very costly one; but in the end it is anticipated that it will be one of our best paying stations. The work requires to be pushed with vigor. The missionaries and their friends need the sympathy and financial support of all our people.

The English Conference continues to treat us with great liberality. They sustain us nobly, by financial aid, and by sending us men to supply our stations. Soon after the last Report was published, they sent us Revs. John Nicholls, R. G. Roscamp, W. Rodwell and A. Sims; all these respected brethren are laboring acceptably among us now, and we hope that by the blessing of God they will serve the Connexion efficiently and successfully for years to come. This year the English Conference has made us a grant of £600=\$2,920. Thus, year by year, they practically—not in mere empty words—tell us they recognize us as being one with themselves, and that they have sympathy with us in our efforts to spread the Gospel and extend the Kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ. In accordance with our request they have appointed Rev. G. Lamb, their retiring Book Steward, to visit us. In all probability he will be here next Spring, and attend the Conference, and we are sure that a hearty reception will be given him by our people in Canada.

By reference to the balance sheet it will be seen that in addition to the usual grant, the English Conference made us a special grant of \$2911 26, with the understanding that it should not be disposed of,

but retained as a balance to assist the Missionary Committee in paying the August and November grants, without being embarrassed previous to the missionary money being paid in. Many thanks are due the English Conference for this liberality. It will be seen that the income this year exceeded that of the previous year by \$555 88. Still it is short of the \$10,000, asked for by last Report, to the amount of \$1372 74. If, however, the advance made last year continues, we shall, in a short time, reach the \$10,000. Suppose all the Stations were to make an united effort to accomplish this much to be desired object, could it not be done the present year. Supposing all our kind friends who have been for many years supporting this Society in its efforts to glorify God by spreading his Gospel, were to resolve that it should be done, the \$10,000 could be raised, and not one of them would know himself the least worse. But think of the good which would be the result, and surely there is in this consideration a motive powerful enough to move every one to do his part to secure success in the undertaking. But how can it be done? If we may be allowed to suggest the plan, suppose each of the subscribers sit down and calculate how much he was worth ten years since, and how much now, and decide on giving in proportion to the increase Divine Providence has made to his possessions. This cannot be thought unreasonable. It is the scriptural plan; and, if adopted, will result in realizing more than the sum asked for. In order to enter the fields that are open to us, and to work efficiently the ground already occupied, the above amount is absolutely needed. Your Missionaries look to the Committee to support them while doing the work to which they are appointed. Your Committee look to you for means by which to support those workers for God; and both look in confidence, feeling they have a right to have confidence. Brethren, God has given to you many blessings, and to many of you much of temporal good. He has put into your hands the power to help His cause, and gives you the blessing and honor of doing so—of being co-workers with him in saving men from the ruin of sin to the glory of heaven.

This great and important work is now placed before you once more in confidence that you will in future, as in the past, support it by your prayers, your efforts, and your liberal contributions, and that He, whose work it is, will abundantly reward you in this world and in that which is to come.
