REPORT.

IN making their first report, the Managers desire very briefly, to remind the public of some of the reasons which led to the establishment of the Home last year.

It had for long been a matter of regret to many in the city, that there was no special or separate place where persons suffering from incurable disease, and who were without relatives or friends able to help them, might have a home and the comforts which their unfortunate condition called for. The Toronto General Hospital is an institution for those diseases which require active medical treatment, and by its regulations, when a case has been so treated, and a cure has not followed, the patient ought to be removed. But when the patient has no means of support, and is without friends to give it, and his disease is found to be incurable, where is he to be removed to? To supply this want was the object of the parties who set about establishing the Toronto Home for Incurables. Meetings were held in the City Hall, and the result was that several ladies, trusting that help would come, and with a blessing upon their efforts, decided to go forward; and they have met with such success as to give hope and confidence for the future.

In selecting the house in Bathurst street for the Home, the Managers were quite alive to the fact that it could only accommodate a limited number of patients, say twenty-four, without undue crowding. But not only was it extremely difficult to find a larger and more suitable building, but caution was needed, lest the funds should fall short in carrying on the good work. A number of ladies were most energetic in making collections which amounted to \$3,146. This was not a large sum to begin with, but a beginning was made. Then followed special donations, and subsequently great help was got from a bazaar, originated and managed by Miss Dick, whose interest and exertions for the Home, in every way, have been beyond all praise. The bazaar realized in all \$1,000.

Mrs. John Beverley Robinson has also placed at the disposal of the Board, a sum of \$800, which had been deposited in the hands of the

City Corporation about twelve years ago. This sum together with the interest upon it, the Board hope soon to receive from the City Council.

The Treasurer's Report shows how the funds, as they stand at present, have been received. The receipts of money, from all sources, at 27th February amounted to \$4,522. But the Managers desire again to acknowledge, with thanks, many donations of meat, clothing, articles of furniture, and other necessaries, sent in by kind friends from time to time. These donations have contributed largely to the comfort of the inmates, and they have materially lessened the expenditure of money in maintaining the Home. The expenditure of money is shown by the Treasurer's report, but it has been found impossible to put a correct money value upon these numerous donations of food, &c., and thus the managers are, as yet, unable to give the actual annual cost of maintaining the Home, or the average cost of each inmate, a point of importance which they wish to know as soon as practicable.

There have been 14 patients admitted into the Home. Of these one died, and two left. Of the remaining eleven (5 men and 6 women), 5 are suffering from paralysis, 2 from chronic rheumatism, 1 from softening of the brain, 1 from consumption, 1 from heart disease, 1 from disease of the hip joint.

Visitors are admitted on Thursday afternoon, between the hours of 3 and 5 o'clock, P. M.

At the outset, all concerned in the management had a good deal to learn. A constitution and bye-laws, based upon the model of similar institutions in England and America, and modified to suit the case, were adopted. When strictly adhered to, these regulations have been proved to work satisfactorily, great care having been found to be absolutely necessary in order to avoid admitting unsuitable persons; and the experience upon this point which has been gained, should go far to prevent recurrence of the difficulties which have arisen. It may not be out of place here to remark that the leading requirements for admission are: 1st. That the person is suffering from incurable disease (which is testified by report of two of the medical staff.) 2nd. That the person has no relatives or friends able to give the means of support (ascertained, so far as practicable, by a Committee of Enquiry). 3rd. That the person is a resident of Toronto (for it was found necessary to restrict admissions to residents of Toronto, because subscriptions were generally given on this understanding).

It is well to add that from the beginning it was decided to make the Home a purely charitable institution, and therefore no payment is demanded from inmates or their friends. The managers consider that their strength in making appeals to the public for contributions lies in this broad fact; and it may also be stated that in considering applications for admission, neither nationality nor creed are taken into account. The question is simply presented in this form: Does the case come within the rules, and is there room for the proposed inmate?

The managers desire to thank those clergymen of the city who have kindly conducted services at the Home each Sunday afternoon. The spiritual as well as the bodily wants of the inmates have thus been cared for as far as practicable; and donations of books and tracts have also been frequent, helping the patients to pass many an hour more pleasantly.

The managers further desire gratefully to acknowledge the kind services of the medical staff, both in examining applicants for admission, prescribing for the inmates, and in regulating their diet, &c. Their assistance has, indeed, been most valuable, and it has been most cheerfully and readily given.

The Matron and Superintendent deserve to be favorably remembered in the report. Their duties have been in many ways trying, calling for patience and continued attention to infirm and sick patients; and both have done all in their power to promote the comfort of the inmates.

Thanks are also due to the city press for taking notice of the affairs of the Home, and giving insertion to notices about donations from time to time.

In conclusion, the Managers wish to express their gratitude to Almighty God for the blessing which has followed and prospered their efforts to relieve the sufferings of some of His destitute ones. They hope and pray that He will continue to vouchsafe His blessing upon the Home and all connected with it, for without this, their efforts must be unavailing; and in His name they call upon the public to continue to support the Home, and to give the means for extended usefulness.

The annual general meeting will be held during the first week in May, according to the By-laws, of which due notice will be given.
