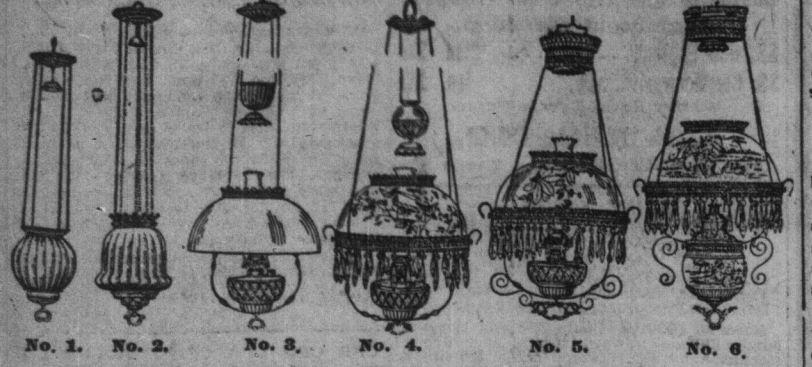

OUR DIMINISHING TRADE WITH GERMANY.

Sir Wilfrid Laurier made Canada a nation by securing the denunciation of a German treaty, but Canada is now paying the penalty of the Premier's dramatic statesmanship. They have in Germany a maximum and a minimum tariff. Previous to the adoption by Canada of the preferential tariff Canada goods entered Germany under the minimum tariff. When Canada decided to denounce the German treaty, she decided to denounce the German tariff. The Emperor thought it was not a fair deal, and he proceeded to retaliate as quickly as the machinery of the law would allow. In consequence of our being subjected to the maximum tariff Canada has practically ceased to ship grain to Germany. The duty on Canadian wheat exported to Germany is now 10 cents per bushel, that is in the United States wheat. It goes without saying that such a discrimination has completely cut out Canadian shipments of wheat to Germany. The only cereals shipped by Canada to Germany is buckwheat, and this trade is really merely because Canada is about the only place from which the grain trade can be supplied. The business we have lost through the denunciation of the German treaty is quite an item, and the matter is engaging the attention of our leading business men, particularly those in the grain trade. How to regulate the trade is a question which the Government should do its best to solve. In spite of the fact that the law would discriminate in favor of Great Britain, our tariff is much more favorable to Germany than is the tariff of the United States. German goods enter Canada under a much lower duty than they enter the United States. Canada is more entitled than the United States to have the advantage of the minimum German tariff. Our tariff on German goods is so favorable that the imports from that country into Canada have of late been increasing very rapidly. German goods of all kinds are found in increasing quantities through Canada, from the Atlantic to the Pacific. In addition to the increasing imports of German goods direct from Germany, a large quantity of German-made articles are imported into Canada through Great Britain. British manufacturers are in the habit of putting a few finishing touches on German products and exporting them to Canada as British goods. By this subterfuge, or evasion of the law, Germany more enjoys the benefit of the preferential treaty.

TAXING OF INSURANCE.

THE NICARAGUA CANAL.

It is to be hoped Great Britain will not accept the amendments that have been made to the Hay-Bunauwili treaty by the U. S. Senate. Even admitting the doctrine of the Monroe doctrine, the United States has no claim to exercise sovereignty powers over the Nicaragua Canal, because the canal is an exercise in violation of the European powers as are vitally interested in the United States. The canal is an international highway, and as such it must remain neutral. It is the United States policy, purely American, and therefore within the scope of the Monroe doctrine, it must not be forgotten that Great Britain has a status on this continent, and is therefore entitled to a voice in the settlement of questions affecting American politics.
