An Act to constitute but one Agricultural Society in and for the United Counties of Chicoutimi and Saguenay.

(PRIVATE BILL.)

WHEREAS, owing to the difficulty of communication, the scattered settlements, and known impossibility of forming a County Agricultural Society in and for the County of Saguenay alone, although the agricultural interests of that County would be greatly advanced by its having a County Society, it is requisite, with the view of promoting and assisting the interests of the agricultural population of that County, that the County of Saguenay should be united to the County of Chicoutimi for that purpose, so as to have but one joint Agricultural Society for the benefit of both;

- Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:
- 1. The Counties of Chicoutimi and Saguenay, as now united for One Society electoral purposes, shall, from and after the passing of this Act, be unifor both ted also for the purpose of forming but one Agricultural Society for Counties.

 15 both Counties, which Agricultural Society shall be known as "The Agricultural Society of the United Counties of Chicoutimi and Saguenay."
- 2. The said Society shall be entitled to receive the grants of To receive public money from the Board of Agriculture, according to section sixty-grants as for one of the thirty-second chapter of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, two Counties.

- 3. For the present year of 1863, the grants appertaining to the said Grants for the two Counties (not exceeding in any case four hundred pounds,) shall present year be paid to the existing Agricultural Society of the County of Chicoutimi (to be called hereafter the Agricultural Society of 25 the United Counties of Chicoutimi and Saguenay), in proportion to the subscriptions raised by the members subscribing thereto, and who may be residents of either County; and until the next election shall take place in January, 1864, the present Presidents, Directors, and Secretary-Treasurer of the existing Agri-30 cultural Society of the County of Chicoutimi, shall, after the passing of this Act, be Presidents, Directors and Secretary-Treasurer of the Agricultural Society of the United Counties of Chicoutimi and Sague-
- 4. At the election in January, 1864, the number of Directors to be Officers for 35 elected for the management of the said Society, shall consist of nine the present members, subscribers in conformity with the Act before cited; and at least two, and not more than four, of the said Directors must be residents of the County of Saguenay; the said election and the management of the said Society's affairs shall be held and carried on at Chicoutimi, the 40 Chef lieu of the County of Chicoutimi, and any four of the officers and directors of the Society shall constitute a quorum.

5. The funds appertaining to the present "Agricultural Society of the County of Chicoutimi," shall become the property of the "Agricul-tural Society of the United Counties of Chicoutimi and Saguenay" from and after the passing of this Act.

Election of Officers in 1864.

6. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act, and shall be construed 5 as forming part of the said thirty-second chapter of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada.
